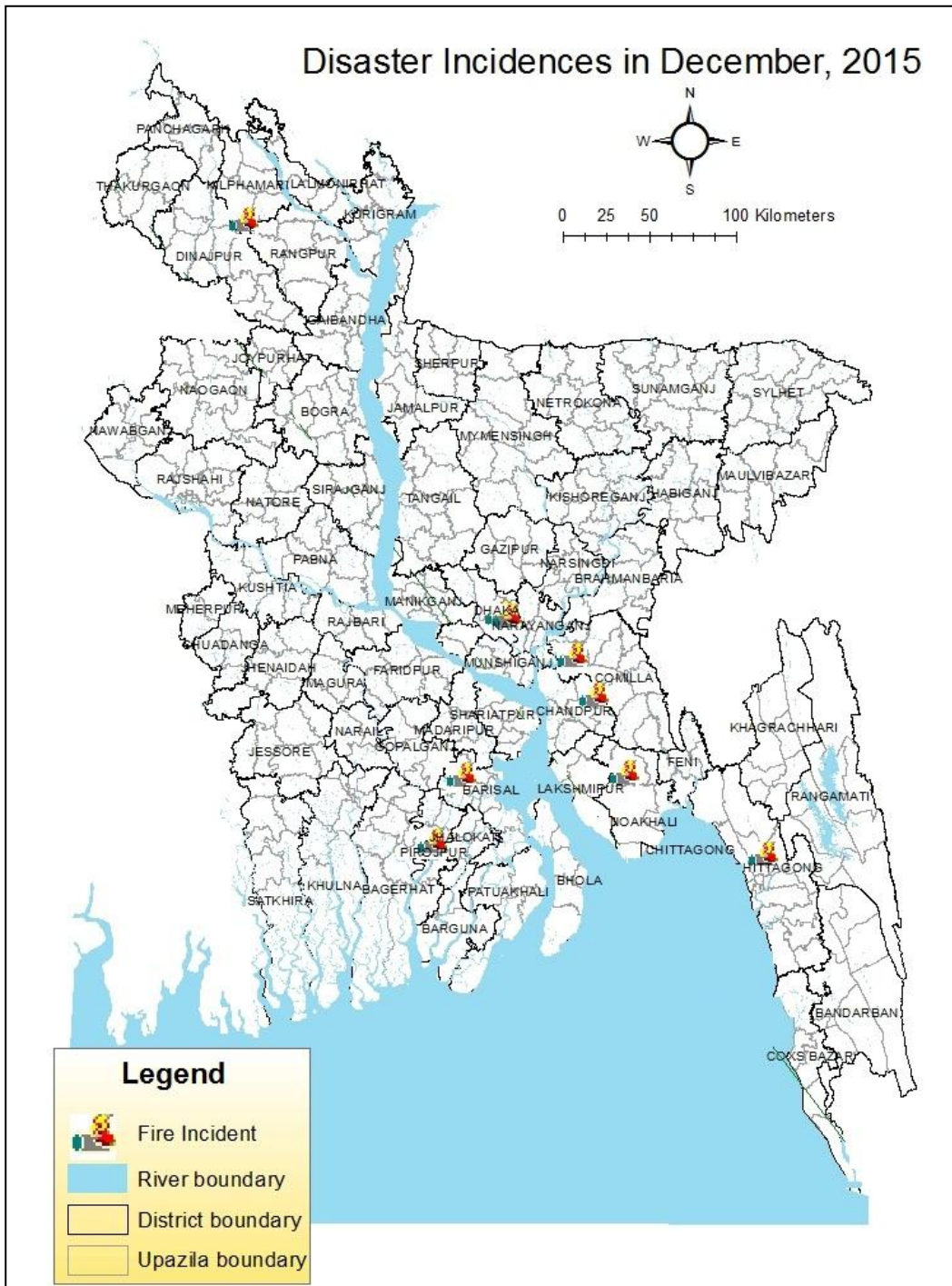




Overview of Hazard Incidences in December 2015

Several incidents of fire have been reported in the month of December, 2015. Fire incidents occurred in eight districts throughout the month. No other disaster incident, excepting fire has been occurred in this month.

Fire Incidents:

Fire incidents occurred in the last half of the month. Nine incidents of fire have been reported in eight districts (Barisal, Comilla, Pirojpur, Noakhali, Nilphamari, Nilphamari, Chandpur, Chittagong, and Dhaka). These incidences of fire gutted around 115 houses and 54 shops and killed 2 children. Estimated losses were of more than BDT 52 lac.
