




































































































## Overview of Hazard Incidences in November 2022

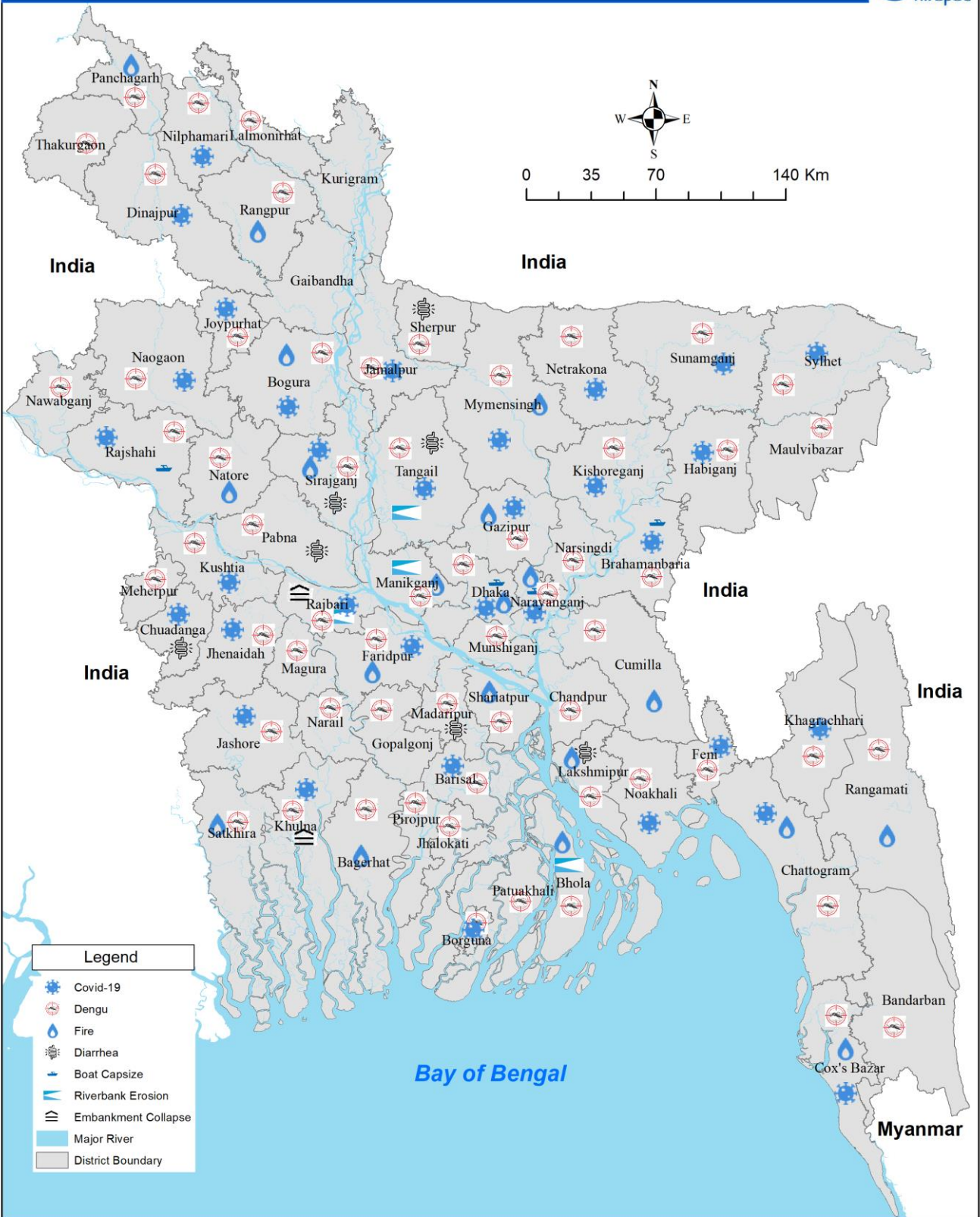
In November 2022, **seven** types of hazard incidents occurred across Bangladesh, including **Boat Capsize, Covid-19, Dengue, Diarrhea, Embankment Collapse, Fire, and Riverbank Erosion**. On the basis of the [DGHS](#) daily situation report, dengue was as severe in November 2022 as it was in the month of October. It caused the death of **106** people and **18,351** confirmed cases were identified throughout **61** districts in this month. Covid-19 affected a total number of **1,251** people in 33 districts for the month of November 2022. According to the national report published by [DGHS](#) in November 2022, due to Covid-19, only **nine** people died and **5,006** recovered. With reference to the daily hazard situation report of [MoDMR](#) and [DDM](#), a total of **551** Fire incidents took place in 20 districts, resulting in the deaths of 1 person and damages of 4 crores and 35 lac taka. **Riverbank Erosion** has had a big impact this month. It took place in 4 different districts i.e., Manikganj, Rajbari, Bhola and Tangail. People did not starve to death, but their homestead, cropland, and many institutions were destroyed.

**4 instances of Boat Capsize** occurred in 4 different districts, which caused the death of **3** people and **5** people went missing in November 2022. Four **Embankment Collapse** occurred in Rajshahi and Khulna districts. Approximately 15 bighas of cropland and 300-meter embankment was washed away into rivers. **Diarrhea** have been running rampant in the month of November 2022. The districts that have been plagued with diarrhea are Sherpur, Madaripur, Lakshmipur, Sirajganj, Chuadanga, Tangail and Pabna. Over thousands of patients were admitted to hospitals and among which **two** people died.

# Monthly Hazard Incident Report in the Month of November, 2022



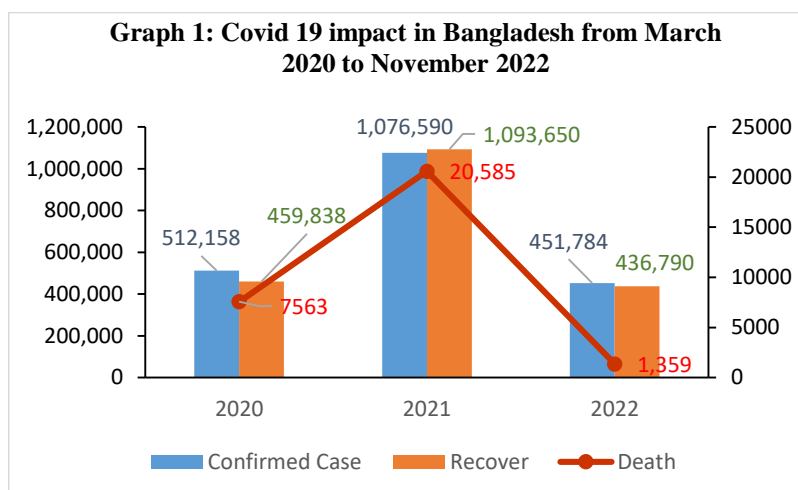
## Description of Hazard Incidents in November 2022

### Dengue

Dengue condition is more or less same as the previous month. As number of confirmed cases went down but the death toll increased in November, 2022. In November, just **61** districts suffered from dengue, and as usual, Dhaka has the highest confirmed cases (**10,036**) and deaths (**66**). In October where the number of confirmed cases was **21,932** while in November it went down to **18,351** confirmed cases and the death toll increased from **86** to **106** people. ### Covid-19

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 was **10,043** from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 31 November 2022. In this month **5,006** people recovered, and the total death was only **nine** which indicates both the number of deaths, and the confirmed cases have decreased compared to the previous month. From the very first case identified on March 8, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patients is **2,036,585** among which **29,433** persons died and **1,985,83** persons recovered from **15,097,870** tested samples in total up to 17 November-2022, according to [DGHS](#). ### Boat Capsize

**Four** instances of Boat Capsize occurred in Brahmanbaria, Rajshahi, Narayanganj and Dhaka on 2, 15, 20 and 24 November respectively, which caused 3 deaths, and 5 missing. In Brahmanbaria 1 person went missing. In Rajshahi 2 females died. The boat capsized that occurred in Narayanganj 1 person died. And Dhaka's boat capsized event resulted in 4 missing person. ### Fire

According to the [NDRCC](#) report and different dailies, 551 fire incidents took place across the country in November 2022. Dhaka Division reported the highest number of fire incidents (155), followed by Khulna division (96), Rajshahi division (91), Rangpur division (52), Mymensingh division (49), Chattogram division (46), Sylhet division (37) and Barishal division (25). Among the 551 incidents, 1 person died and several property damages were recorded. The estimated damage was recorded around 4 crores and 35 lacs taka. [For more details see in Annex 2.](#)

**Total: 1 died & 143 houses, 269 shops, 2 factories, a multi-storied building, 2 warehouses, a market and a bank was burnt. 4 crore and 35 lac taka in estimated losses.**

## Diarrhea

Diarrhea have been running rampant in the month of November 2022. The districts that have been plagued with diarrhea are Sherpur, Madaripur, Lakshmipur, Sirajganj, Chuadanga, Tangail and Pabna. 1539 patients with severe diarrhea cases were admitted into hospitals and among which two people died. ## Embankment Collapse

Four Embankment Collapse occurred on 5, 9, 10 and 11 November 2022 in Dhaka and Khulna respectively where villages were at risk. Approximately 15 bigha of cropland and 300-meters embankment was washed away into the rivers. See bellow table for more details.

## Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion has a big impact in this month. It took place in four different districts i.e., Manikganj, Rajbari, Bhola and Tangail in several days. People did not starve to death, but their homestead, cropland, many institutions were destroyed. Cropland and several establishments were destroyed in Tangail district in November 2022. ## GoB Response in November 2022

### Response to Covid-19 up to 28 November 2022

As of 28 November 2022, **147,925,350** individuals received their first dose, **125,238,255** completed their two-dose schedule, and **59,013,449** received the COVID-19 booster dose. More than **86.9%** of the total population received the first dose, and **73.5%** completed the two doses schedule (as per the estimated population of 170 317 077, by Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics, 1 July 2021). The male and female ratio was 49.7% and **50.3%** respectively, among the people who received full dose of vaccine. For details-[WHO](#).

### Response to Fire

On 19 November, 2022 a huge fire broke out in Uttara, Dhaka damaging about 100 houses in the event. 5,000 taka in response was provided to each household to help them get back on their feet by Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC).

## Conclusion

A total **seven** types of hazard took place in November 2022 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities. The government took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary steps to provide support to the distressed people.
