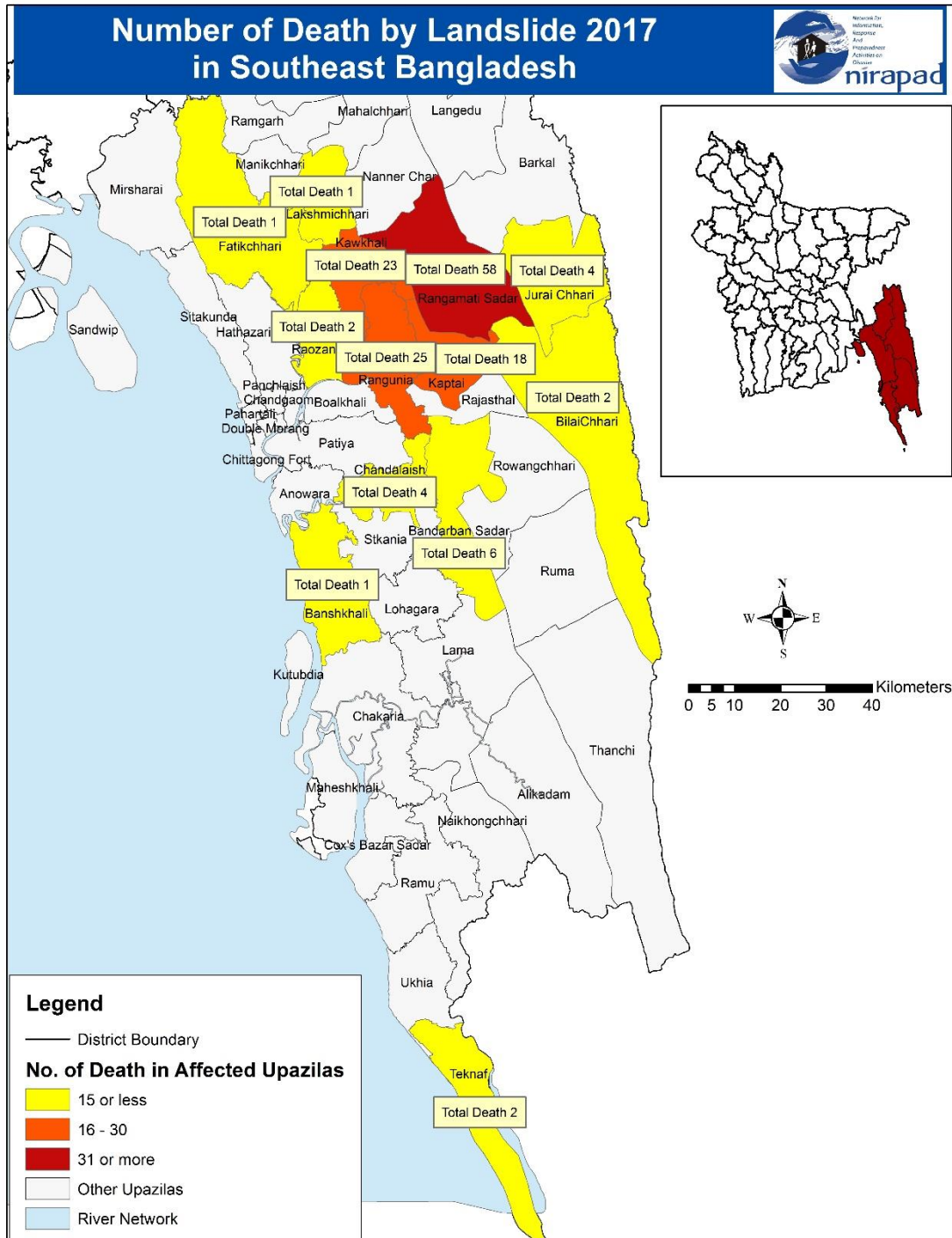




Overview of Landslides, June 2017

Depression originated at northwest Bay of Bengal and adjacent areas causes extreme rainfall in the coastal regions on June 12, 2017 and triggered massive landslides in five districts of southeast Bangladesh i.e. Rangamati, Bandarban, Chittagong, Cox's Bazar and Khagrachhari. About 146 people including several rescuer (officers and members of the army) have been killed by this landslides in these five districts. Scores more were hurt and many remained missing. Rescue operations were delayed due to bad weather, but were continuing with difficulties.



Overall Impact Scenario of Landslides, June 2017

The Chittagong Hill Tracts observed over 300 mm of rainfalls in the 24 hours till June 13th morning. Chittagong alone experienced 222 mm of rain during the same period. None of these areas has seen such rain in recent years. As a result, much of the low-lying areas of the hill districts went under water. As well, this torrential rainfall triggered massive landslides in five districts of southeast Bangladesh i.e. Rangamati, Bandarban, Chittagong, Cox's Bazar and Khagrachhari. These landslides killed many people who remained in their shanty-like homes at the foot of the hills risking their lives, despite warnings by the local administrations. About 146 people including four army personnel have died in these hilly areas following incessant downpour overnight. The rescue operations are still going on. It is estimated that number of death may increase. About 5,770 people are now living in different shelters in Rangamati, Bandarban and Chittagong.

GoB Response in Landslides, June 2017

Government of Bangladesh took immediate response on this hazardous incident. GoB through District Relief and Rehabilitation Officer, allocated GR cash and GR rice in the affected districts (see table 02 below). Moreover, Mr. Obaydul Quader, Minister of Road Transport and Bridge, has announced BDT 5,000,000, 100 MT rice and 500 bundle of C. I. sheet for assistance of the affected people of these areas, while visited Rangamati on 14th June.

Conclusion

Excessive rainfall in these areas due to the depression in northwest Bay of Bengal was the underlying cause of the devastating landslides and numerous death. Although the rescue operations were so quick, due to bad weather, rescue operations couldn't be done effectively. The actual impact scenario can be known as many people are still stuck in the landslides and the rescue operations are still going on. GoB has taken immediate steps as the form of response to the affected areas.
