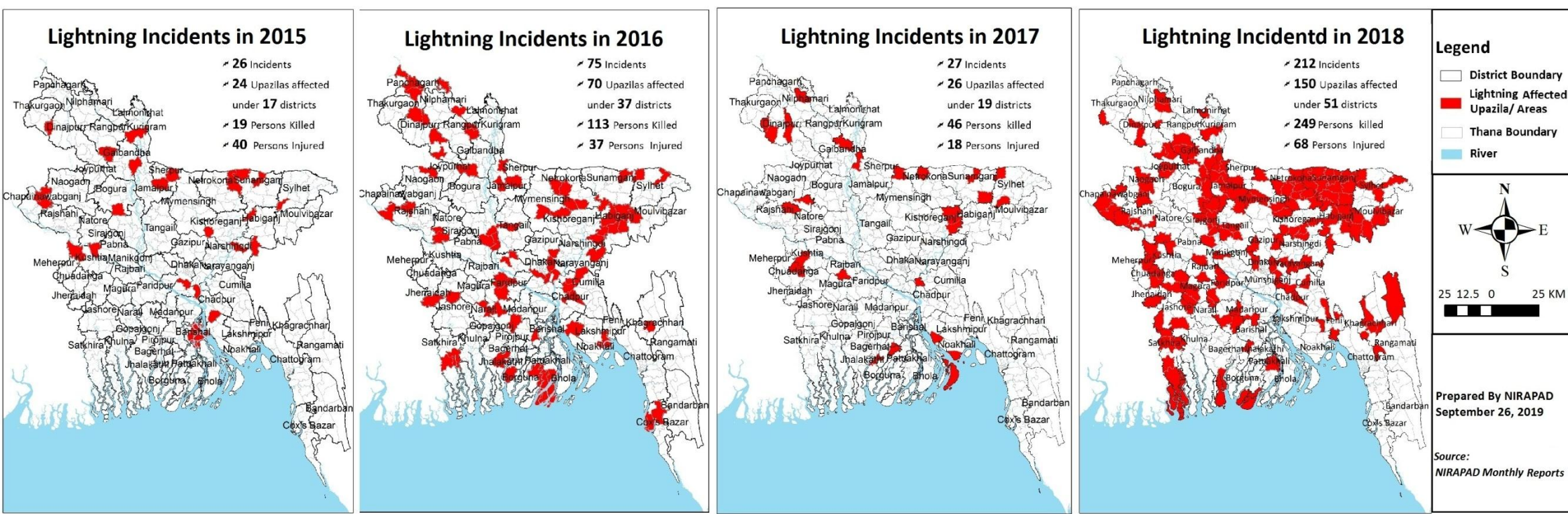


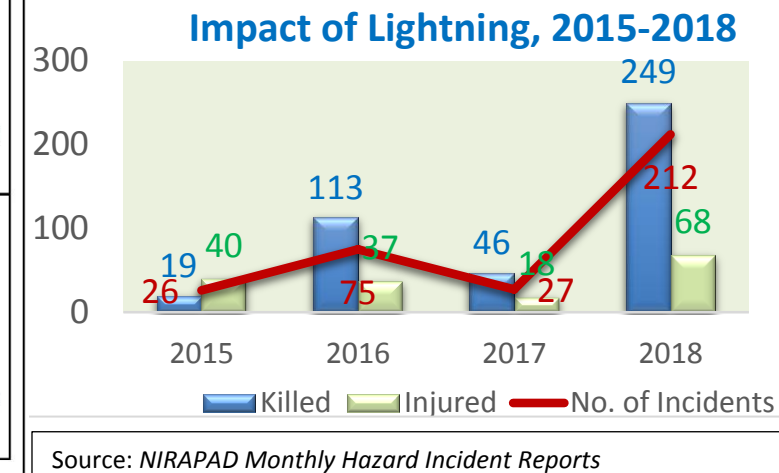


Spatial Distribution of Lightning Incidents, 2015-2018

Lightning Safety Tips

- Use lightning conductor at the building to prevent lightning strike
- Keep a close watch on surroundings & remain alert during
- Take shelter in building & stay away from tall trees, electric poles, If not possible then stay 4 meter from tree & 45° away
- Shut down the windows & stay inside the room
- Unplug TV, fridge & other electronic devices
- Don't use telephone as telephone line is not safe in lightning
- Don't touch metal objects e.g. water taps and pipes, stair railings etc.
- Avoid open or elevated places; if not possible, stay away 50-100 feet from each other
- Use rubber boots & don't stay barefoot but never use wet leather shoes
- Use umbrella with wooden or plastic made handle
- Avoid going to the streets or water-bodies to avoid snapped electric-lines hidden in the logged water
- If you are in a car and don't touch the windshields
- Don't go to boating or fishing; if not possible then stay under boat shed

- Call emergency
- Check vital signs
- Lift chin check breathing
- Give rescue breaths
- Perform CPR
- Repeat step 4 to 5 until help arrives

Additional instructions: If no shelter found nearby, sit down on the ground keeping weight on toe & put hand in the ear but never lay down on the ground. If anybody gets hurt, try to take him/her to the hospital as soon as possible.
