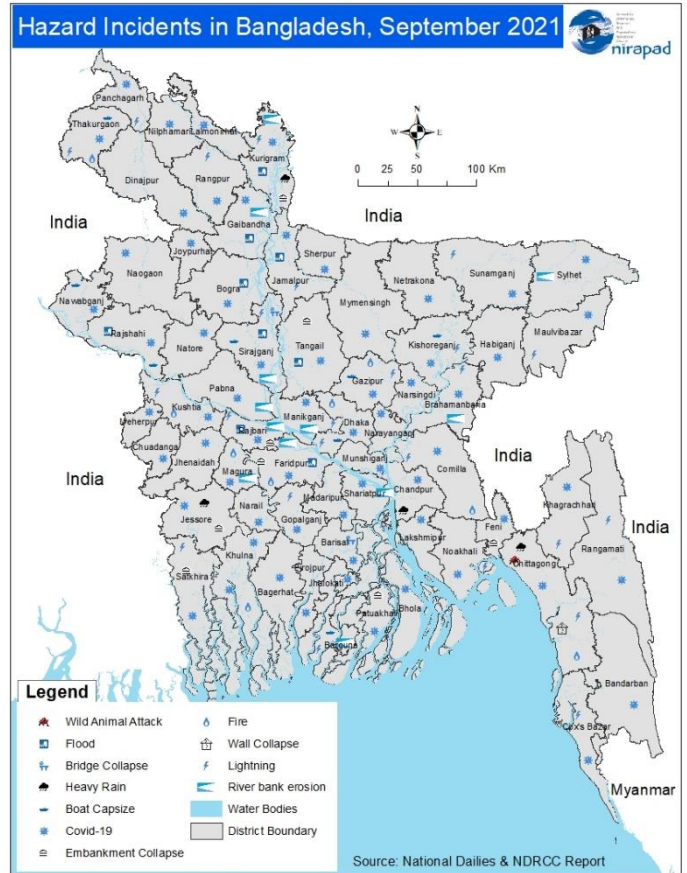




Overview of Hazard Incidences in September 2021

In September 2021, a total of **11** types of hazards took place across Bangladesh i.e. COVID 19, Lightning, Boat Capsize, Flood, Fire Incident, Heavy Rainfall, Riverbank Erosion, Embankment Collapse, Bridge Collapse, Wild Animal Attack, Wall Collapse. Among them, **COVID 19** affected a total of **52,231** persons across the country in September. **1,136** persons died and **83,993** persons recovered from COVID-19 according to the national report of **September, 2021**. **Lightning** was another severe hazard that took life of **34** persons across **24** districts according to national dailies. In **9 districts** **17** people died and **4** people were reported missing in separate **Boat Capsize**. Due to **flood** in the first half of this month 9 districts reported heavy damage. **7,799** hectares of crop lands reported being damaged, and **1,117,966** families were affected according to **NDRCC** reports, and multiple educational and religious institutes were also damaged due to the flood. According to **NDRCC** reports **292** fire incidents took place throughout the country, in which 4 people died. **Bridge Collapsed** in two separate districts and no injuries were reported. **Riverbank Erosion** took place in Bogura, Brahmanbaria, Faridpur, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Magura, Manikganj, Shariatpur, Sylhet, Shirajganj, Pabna, Rajbari districts causing widespread damage to lives, properties, crops and croplands. **Heavy Rainfall** was reported in Kurigram. **Embankment Collapsed** in Feni, Faridpur, Jashore, Kurigram, Rajbari, Shatkhira, Tangail and Potuakhali. **Wild Animal Attack** was reported in chattogram, huge numbers of rats wreaked havoc in the farmlands of sitakunda upazila. **Wall Collapsed** in Bangladesh bank's office, Chattogram 7 people were reported injured in the incident.

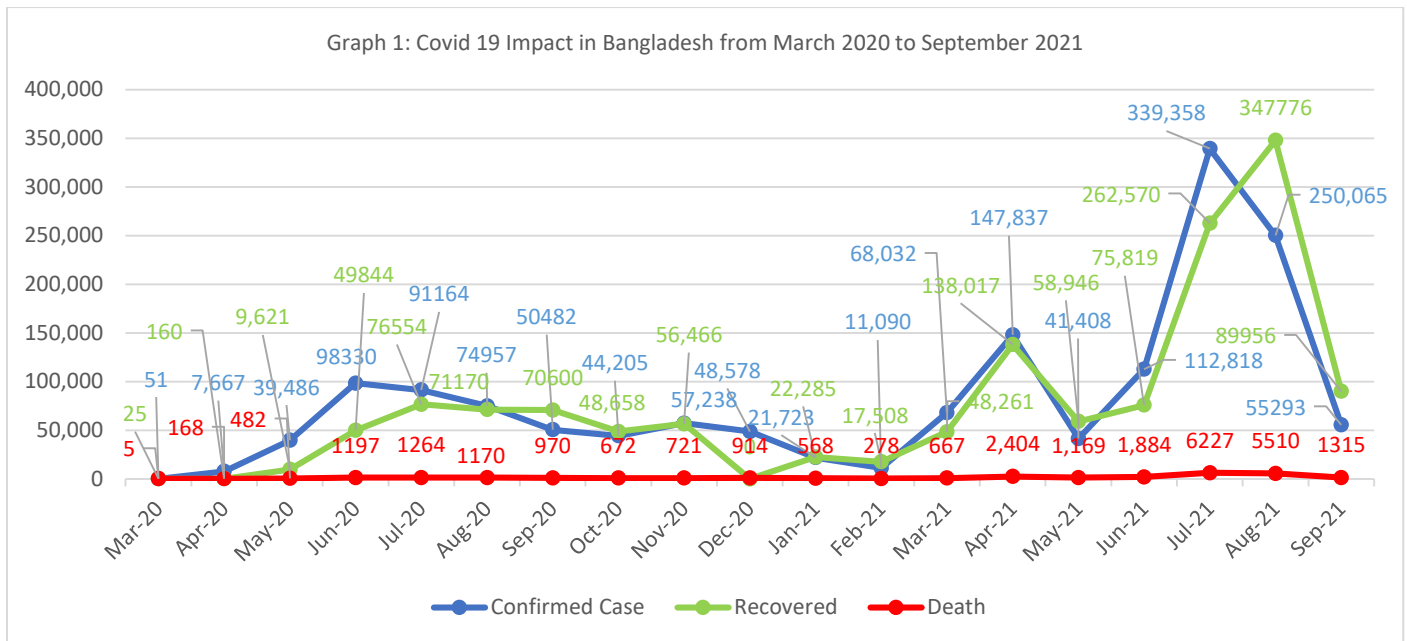

Description of Hazard Incidents in September 2021

Covid-19 Pandemic in Bangladesh

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 is reported **52,231** from 1st September to 30th September 2021. In this month **83,993** persons recovered and total death was **1,336** which indicates both the number of deaths and the confirmed case is declining. From the very first case identified on March 8, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patients is **15,55,911** among which **27,510** persons died and **15,15,941** persons recovered up to September 30, 2021. Lightning

Cases of lightning are reported in 24 districts. Among them Kurigram, Gazipur, Gopalganj, Rangamati had the highest number of casualties. A total of 30 people lost their lives, another 14 were injured. Majority of casualties were of the farmers working in open spaces and Fisherman's catching fish in large water bodies. 5 houses were burnt (Kalerkontho.com 27-Sep 21) due to lightning and estimated losses of tk 30 lakh. Flood

Flood caused widespread damage in the first half of September, 2021. 9 districts reported heavy damage i.e. Rajbari, Bogura, kurigram, Tangail, Jamalpur, sirajganj, rajshahi, Gaibandha and Faridpur. **7,799** hectares of crop lands reported being damaged, **1,117,966** families were affected according to NDRCC reports, and multiple educational and religious institutes were also damaged because of the flood. Boat Capsize

In 8 districts, all over Bangladesh, namely Rajshahi, Dhaka, Kishorganj, Sirajganj, Gazipur, Thakurgaon, Barguna, Chapainawabganj boat capsized occurred. 17 people died and 4 people were reported missing. The bagha upazilla of Rajshahi zilla had the greatest number of boat capsizing incidents. Further Details regarding Boat Capsize are given below.

Fire

According to the NDRCC report and different dailies, 292 fire incidents took place around the country. Dhaka division Reported the highest number of fire incidents (92), Followed by Chattogram division (57), Khulna division (36), Rangpur division (32), Mymensingh division (31), Rajshahi division (22), Sylhet division (16) and Barishal division (6). Among the 292 incidents 15 were reported in which 4 people died, 29 people were injured, 14 were damaged. The estimated damage was over 22 crore taka. See more details in **Annex 4**.

Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion affected with huge loss of lives, properties, croplands as well as crops. 12 districts in total reported riverbank erosion namely, Bogura, Brahmanbaria, Faridpur, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Magura, Manikganj, Rajbari, Shariatpur, Sylhet, Pabna and Sirajganj respectively. In total 920 houses and 2 schools and 3 mosques and 30.02 acre land were washed away while 6 schools are in risk in washing away due to riverbank erosion. Details of the riverbank erosion impacts were addressed in the below table.

Embankment Collapse

In September, 2021, in total 7 districts reported embankment damage; these were Feni, Faridpur, Kurigram, Rajbari, Shatkhira, Tangail, Potuakhali. In total 22700 reported being damaged in addition 17 villages were also damaged. Another 2800 hectares of cropland faced water logging due to embankment collapse.

Heavy Rainfall

Heavy Rainfall was reported in Kurigram only. 78.8 mm of rainfall was recorded on 18th September and 152.4mm in Chittagong on 19th September. The daily activities came to a standstill. Waterlogging occurred due to the excessive precipitation in the region. Moreover, a total of 5 waterlogging incidents were reported in daily newspapers. In Chandpur, Matlab meghna dhangoda irrigation project faced waterlogging. Total 914.1 acre of cropland damaged (Ittefaq.com 18 Sep 21)

Bridge Collapse

2 bridges collapsed in September 2021 in Bangladesh. 4000 people from 5 villages in sirajganj district shahzadpur upazila have been facing difficulties in their everyday commute (Jugantor.com 13-Sep 21) another one in Barisal Sadar (Abnews24.com 15 Sep 21) where People faced traffic problems due to no alternative routes.

Wildlife Animal Attack

In Chattogram district Sitakunda upazila, an unnatural number of rats caused heavy damage to croplands affecting more than 20 thousand farmers. (Source: Kalerkontho.com 25/09/2021). No government actions were reported as the authority claimed no additional funds are provided for dealing with rats.

Wall Collapse

Wall collapsed in Bangladesh bank's Chattogram branch injuring 7 people. (Source: Bdnews24.com 12 sep 21)

GoB Response in September 2021

Response to Covid-19 up to September 27th, 2021

A Total of **440,023,46** persons registered for vaccine till 27th September 2021 among which the GoB managed to vaccinate 1st dose of covid-19 vaccines to **245,786,46** ([WHO](#)) people starting from January 27, 2021, to September 2021. From April 08, 2021, to September 2021, a total of **163,124,60** people got 2nd doses of vaccines. People received 1st doses of vaccine till 27th September was 14.2% of total population where male received 56% and female were 44%.

Response to Flood

In total 12 districts, GoB allocated and distributed hand cash and GR rice in response to flood. Details are given below table:

Response to Boat Capsize

- In Barguna, NDRCC reported that 4 demises family got 25000 taka in total 1 lakh.
- In Chapainawabganj, NDRCC reported that 2 demises family got each 25000 taka in total 50,000 taka.

Response to Riverbank Erosion

In Feni district, 12 metric ton rice and 10,000 tk in GR were provided for the incidence of 8 September, 2021 to the damaged families. [NDRCC](#) 7 September, 2021.

Conclusion

A total of 11 hazards took place this month with multiple casualties of life and asset across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities. Govt. took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary steps to provide support to the distressed people.
