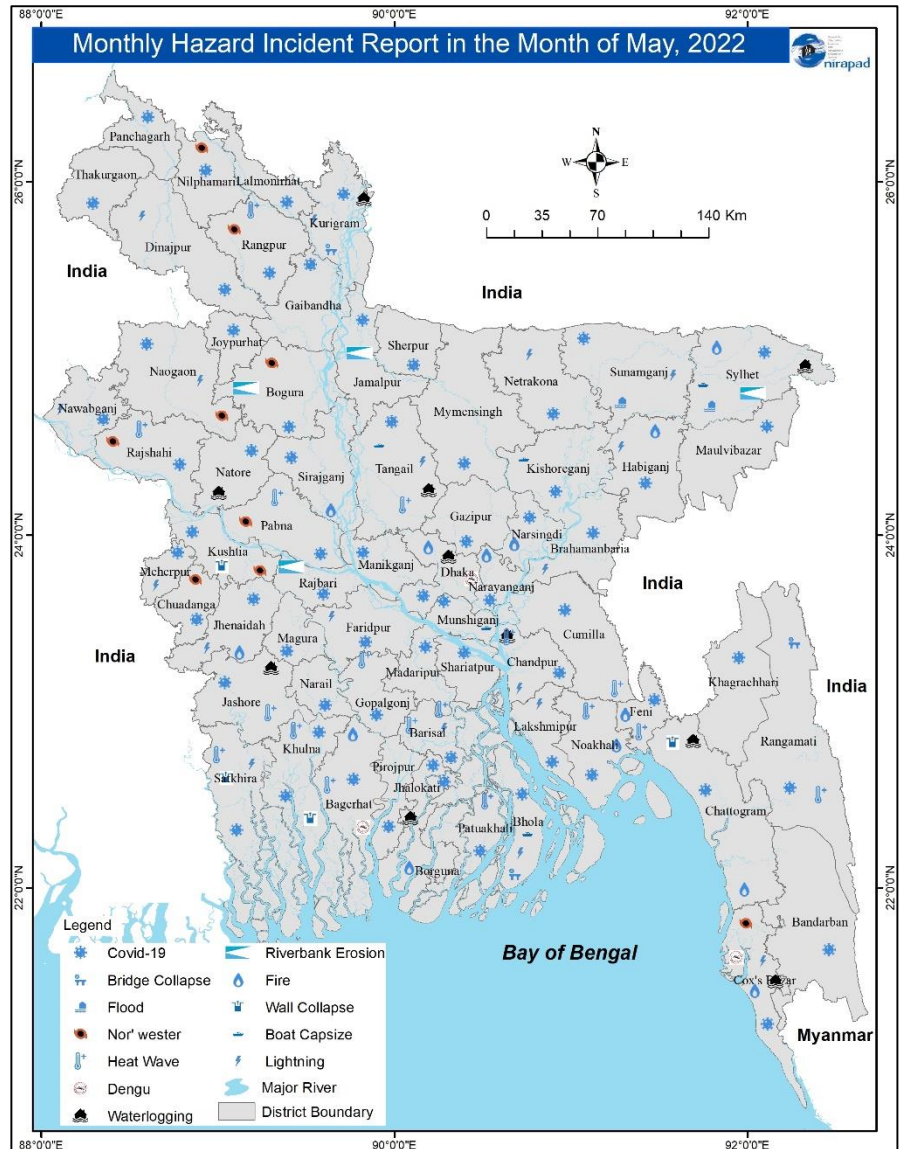




Overview of Hazard Incidences in May 2022

In May 2022, **12** hazards took place across Bangladesh i.e., **Covid-19, Fire, Boat Capsize, Nor'wester, Lightning, Wall Collapse, Waterlogging, Dengue, Heat-Wave, Flood, Riverbank Erosion, and Bridge Collapse**. Among them, **Covid 19** affected a total of **7,356** people across the country and only **4** people died and **14,100** are recovered according to the national report of **May 2022**. [NDRCC](#) reports, A total of **581** Fire incidents took place throughout the country, in which **8** people died, and **14** are injured. **6** Boat Capsize incidents took place this month where a total of 3 people died and 5 are missing. Nor'wester hit entire districts of Bangladesh which resulted in 2 demises and 14 people injuries. **Lightning** is the most devastating this month causing 36 deaths, 20 injured and 1 missing. 4 people died and 5 are seriously injured due to wall collapse this month while Waterlogging caused marooned households in several districts. 163 confirmed case of **Dengue** is newly identified in 3 districts this month. 4 mild **Heat Wave** is reported with no casualties this month. Flash flood appeared in 2

districts namely Sunamganj and Sylhet which affected houses and households, damaged crops, and roads, and washed away fish, and dead cattle, poultry in several Upazila of the two districts. **Riverbank Erosion** washed away land and homestead in several districts. 2 **Bridge Collapse** events took place which badly disrupted the transportation system.

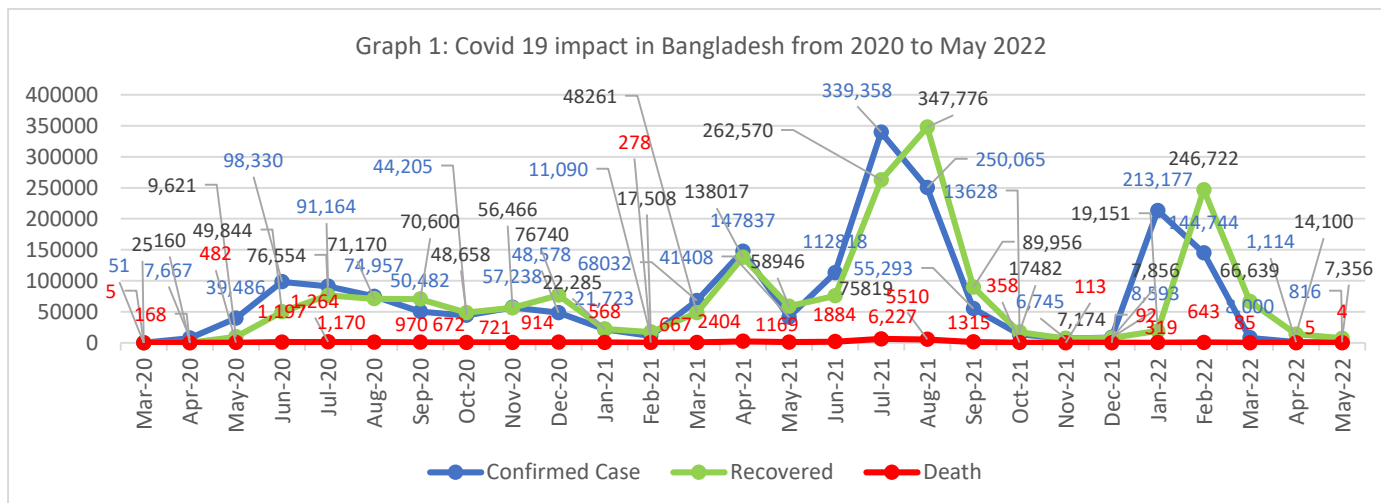

Description of Hazard Incidents in May 2022

Covid-19 Pandemic in Bangladesh

In May 2022, the newly identified patients with Covid-19 were only 816. In this month **7,356** persons recovered and only 4 demises were recorded due to covid 9. which indicates both the number of deaths and the confirmed cases are decreasing in contrast with the previous month. From the very first case identified, on March 8, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patients is **19,56,599** among which **29,204** persons died and **19,07,456** persons recovered from **14,112,902** tested samples in total up to May 31st, 2022, according to dghs.gov.bd and WHO. Boat Capsize

6 boat capsizing incidents took place in 5 districts on several dates in May, 2022. Boat capsizing on 13th and 16th May in Sylhet district causes 1 demise and 1 missing respectively. 2 farmers are missing and 1 bulkhead & 2 Trawler were drowned by Boat capsizes on 21st May. 1 woman died and 1 child whereabouts is unknown due to the boat capsizing on 31 May. Fire

The following table depicted that on the basis of the report [DDM](#), [NDRCC](#) and different national dailies including the online portal, 581 fire incidents took place throughout the country in May month. Dhaka Division reported the highest

number of fire incidents (159), followed by Chattogram division (116), Rajshahi division (67), Rangpur division (55),

Barishal division (55), Khulna division (54), Mymensingh division (41) and Sylhet division (34) respectively. Among the **581** incidents 8 demises, 14 injured, 368 shops, 13 house & 2 transformer burnt. The estimated damage was over around 4 crores 23 lakh taka. See more details in **Annex 3**.

Nor 'wester

In May, 5 Nor 'wester events were occurred all over the country. Devastating nor 'wester caused died of 2 people and injured 22 while more than 500 house 264 electric poles and 816 hectare of crops damaged in several districts of Bangladesh. Communication system was vastly disrupted by uprooting trees on road. More than 4 lakh people are

Lightning

Lightning took place in 23 districts across the country which left 36 killed and 20 injured and 1 remain missing. A total 10 cows were died due to lightning events in May. The affected districts are namely Tangail, Brahmanbaria, Meherpur, Habiganj, Bagerhat, Faridpur, Cox's Bazar, Chadpur, Dinajpur, Cumilla, Barishal, Naogaon, Jaypurhat, Pabna, Bogura, Kurigram, Sunamganj, Netrokona, Nawabganj, Jhenaidah, Lauxmipur, Bhola, and Satkhira respectively. Wall Collapse

There are 4 wall collapses took place in this month in 4 districts of Bangladesh which resulted 4 people died including women and children and 5 are injured. The affected districts are Chattagram, Khulna, Kustia and satkhira. Table 4 show the more details of wall collapse in May month 2022.

Waterlogging

7 incidents of waterlogging occurred in 7 districts i.e. Chattagram, Sylhet, Barisal, Cox's Bazar, Dhaka, Tangail, Natore and Jhalokathi respectively. Communication was heavily disrupted due to inundation of roads, different household

become marooned due to heavy rainfall, 400 bigha paddy cultivation is disrupted due to waterlogging in May month. Details are given in **Table 5**

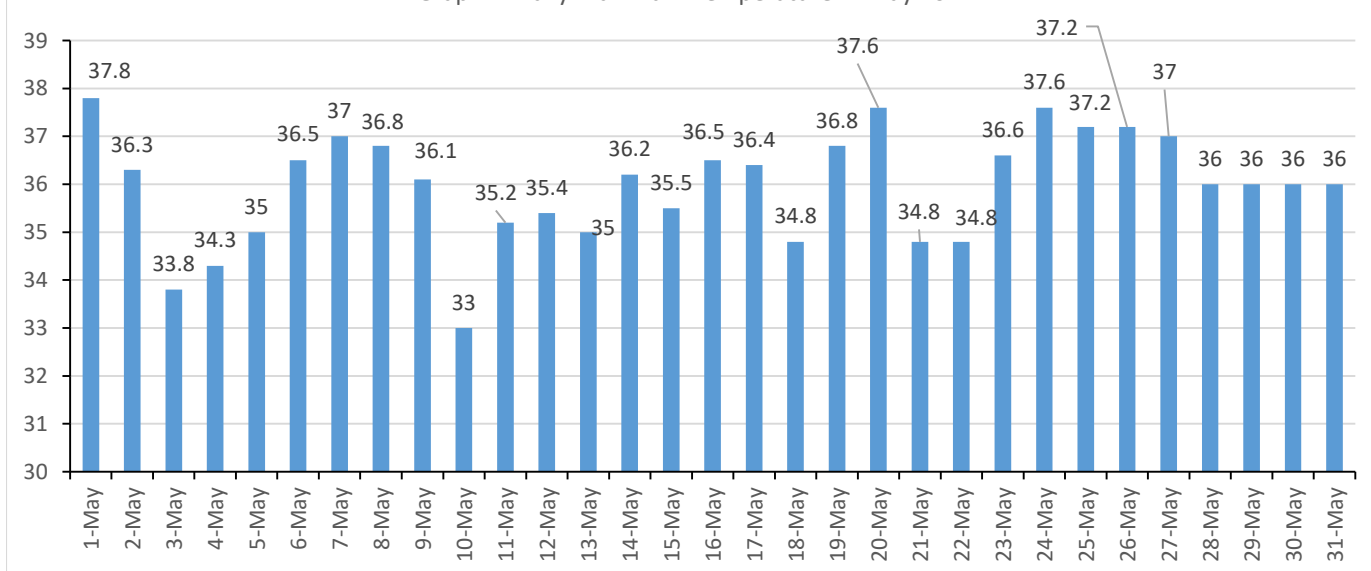
Dengue

Dengue made a negative impact in 3 districts as Dhaka Mohanagar, Cox's Bazar and Bagerhat districts in May 2020. A total 163 confirmed case was recorded while no demises news was recorded. Among 163 confirmed case, 161 cases were recorded at Dhaka Mohanagar while in Bagerhat and Cox's bazar both district the confirmed case recorded 1. dghs.gov.bd. **Annex 5 addressed more details.**

Heat Wave

In May 2022, the country experienced 4 mild heat wave in several days. The first one was flown on 8 and 9 May in 9 districts while the second one was flown from 17th May to 20th May in 10 districts. The third and fourth heat wave was flown on 25th and 27th of May in 9 and 5 districts respectively. Among 4 heat waves, no casualties were recorded. The maximum temperature in May month was recorded at 37.8^o c in Jashore district on 1st May. [DDM 1 May](#)

Flash Flood

A devastating flash flood event took place in 2 districts namely Sunamganj and Sylhet from 14th to 21st May 2022. In **Sunamganj** district, total 5 upazila namely Chhatak, Sunamganj Sadar, Doarabazar, Bishwambharpur, and Tahirpur are vastly affected. 1,100 hectares of Buro Paddy, 130 hectares seedbed of Aush, 30 hectares Aush paddy, 60 hectares' vegetables and 95 hectares' almonds are marooned by water. 168 tons of fish have been washed away in 310 ponds and about 50 tons of fry have been washed away (bdnews24 24 May). 552 km road damaged and eight bridges and a rubber dam have collapsed (prothomalo 30 May). The estimated damage was 150 crores. 216 Schools flooded and 28 temporarily closed (bdnews24 18 May). 6 thousand families become waterlogged at Chattak and 70 families took

shelter in 3 schools (prothomalo.com 17 May 22). 12 unions are facing significant displacement. See Annex 5 for more details

In **Sylhet** district, almost 13 Upazila and 42 unions and many areas in the Sylhet City including the Shahjalal Upashahar, Misimpur, Sobhanighat, Terorat, Kalighat, Chhararpar, Sheikhghat, Kazirbazar, Taltola, Kushighat, Mendibag went under water. Breaching of 34 dams on the Surma and Kushiara rivers. Around 3,25,000 people and 65,000 households have been impacted due to the flood. A total of 725 houses were damaged (613 partially and 112 fully). 96 people have been affected due to waterborne disease reportedly from the Sylhet Civil Surgeon's Office. As per the Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE), 370 tube wells and 3,659 toilets were affected. 534 schools affected. According to the Department of Livestock Services data on Sylhet Division, 167,817 cows, 8,717 buffalo, 43,478 goats, 20,379 sheep, 728,593 poultry, and 405,514 ducks were affected by the flood as of 30 May 2022. Death of 105 livestock animals (cattle) and 22,934 poultry in Sylhet division have been reported by DLS as of 30 May 2022. [NAWG](#)

Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion affected with huge loss of house, household, properties and dam in 5 districts i.e. Jamalpur, Tangail, Rajbari, Bogura, and Sylhet in May 2022. 2000 families are at risk due to active riverbank erosion of Padma river. (Source: prothomalo.com 16-May 22). 25 families are affected by the active erosion of Surma river by increasing the water due to heavy upstream rainfall. (prothomalo.com 16-May 22). 40-meter section of the Jamuna river flood control dam collapsed at Miapara village in Kulkandi union of Islampur upazila of Jamalpur district. (prothomalo.com

21-May 22). 500 houses disappear into the river at char kakua union by the erosion of jamuna river at Tangail Sadar Upazila. (prothomalo.com 22 May 22). 180 meters' area disappeared into river and affected 300 family at Dhunot Upazila, Bogura district (prothomalo.com 24-May 22). 50 houses washed away into the river at Char Pakerdaha union at pakrul village at Madamganj Upazila jamalpur district ([prothomalo](http://prothomalo.com) 26 May 22).

Bridge Collapse

2 incidences of bridge collapse occurred back to back date in Bhola and Kurigram districts on 17th and 18th May. Bridge Collapse at Char fashion Upazila under the district of Bhola on 17th May caused to appear extreme distress among passengers and the transportation was disrupted between Bhola and Char Fashion regional roads. (Source: ittefaq.com. 17-May 22). A recently constructed bridge collapsed from its three months of inauguration at Fulbari Upazila, Kurigram district on 18th May 2022 (Source: ittefaq.com 18-May 22). No casualties were recorded but the normal life of the local community was vastly disrupted.

GoB Response in May 2022

Response to Covid-19 up to May 29, 2022

As of 29 May 2022, 128,759,322 individuals received their first dose, 117,565,106 completed their two-doses schedule and 15,039,802 individuals received the COVID-19 booster dose. Coverage percentage of - 1st dose and 2nd dose is 75.6%, 69.0% respectively. The male and female ratio was 49.8% and 50.2% among the people who received the first dose and 49.5% and 50.5% respectively for the second dose ([WHO](#))

Response to flash flood

Sylhet District: DLS response to this flood was to vaccinate 17,591 cattle and 22,244 poultry. As of 23 May 2022, Sylhet district administration has distributed 551 MT rice, 11800 packages of dry food, and cash support of BDT 1500,000. In Sylhet 326 Flood shelter have been prepared where 7439 people are staying in 95 shelters as of May 19, 2022. Besides, 199 flood shelters have been equipped with WAH facilities and DPHE of Sylhet raised 35 tube well and disinfected another 31 damaged tube wells. [NAWG Report](#).

Sunamganj District: In Sunamganj, District Administration till date allocated 140 Metric Ton rice, BDT 1200,000 G.R Cash and 2000 Dry food packages as well 56 flood shelter also have been prepared [NAWG Report](#).

Conclusion

A total of **12** hazards took place this month of May 2022 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a little bit loss of lives with huge of properties and disrupted daily activities of human being. The government as well as non-government organizations took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary steps to provide support to the distressed people.
