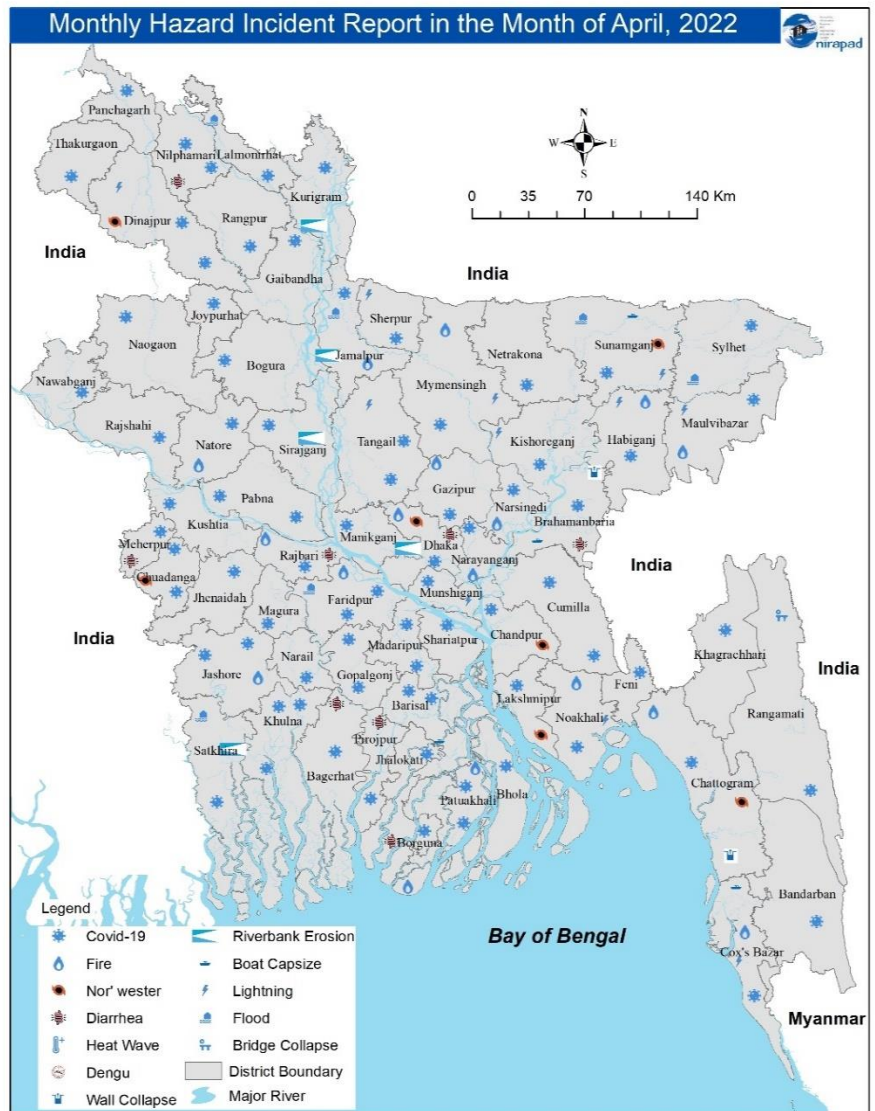




Overview of Hazard Incidences in April 2022

In April 2022, 12 hazards occurred across Bangladesh, including **Covid-19, Fire, Boat Capsize, Riverbank Erosion, Heat Wave, Wall Collapse, Dengue, Lightning, Nor 'wester, Flash Flood, and Diarrhea.**

The most devastating of which was Covid 19, which affected a total of **1,114** people across the country in a single month. According to the national report published in April 2022, 5 people died and **14,100** people were rescued from the rubble. According to the NDRCC, a total of 636 fire incidents occurred throughout the country, resulting in the deaths of 121 people and the injuries of 15 others. 7 northwester occurred all over the world, causing significant damage. Three people died, and the majority of farmers lost their crops as a result in Northwester. Riverbank erosion has also decreased in comparison to the previous month. It took place only five times, in five different neighborhoods. People did not starve to death, but their homes were destroyed. In the month of April, a wall collapsed, injuring 10. It was reported that there were three heat wave incidents this month, and the highest temperature was recorded at **41.2** degrees Celsius on the 16th of April in Dinajpur, pabna, Khulna and faridpur District. District. A mild heat wave has been affecting Dinajpur, Tangail, Faridpur, Pabna, and Jeshore from the 15th to the 19th of April. As a result of the extreme heat of the summer, diarrhea has been widespread throughout the country this month. Some of the hospital's wards were crammed with diarrhea patients. Dengue fever has a noticeable impact on the month of April as well. On the month April, 22, three confirmed cases were identified, with the majority of patients housed in Dhaka.



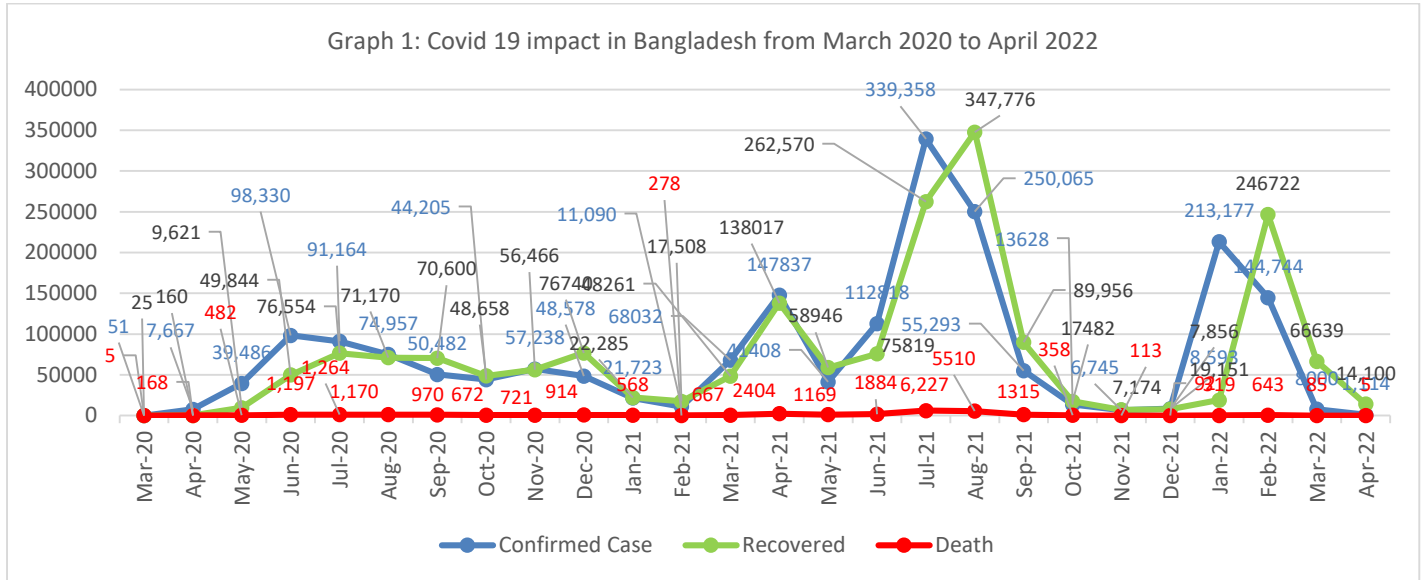

Description of Hazard Incidents in April 2022

Covid-19 Pandemic in Bangladesh

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 was **1,114** from 1st April to 30th April 2022. In this month **14,100** persons recovered and the total death was **5** which indicates both the number of deaths and the confirmed cases are decreasing compared to the previous month. From the very first case identified on March 8, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patients is **19,55,783** among which **29200** persons died and **19,00,100** persons recovered from **13,961,944** tested samples in total up to April 24th, 2022, according to [WHO](#) See **Annex 1** and **Annex 2** for more details on the month of April.



Boat Capsize

When compared to the previous month, the number of boat capsizes has dropped this month. The capsizing of four vessels took place in four distinct districts. There was an accident in Cox's Bazar (Nazirtek) on April 2nd, but all of the fishermen were able to be saved. On the 8th of April, an accident occurred in Mehediganj, and on the 19th of April, two separate accidents occurred in Sunamganj and Brahmanbaria, resulting in the deaths of five individuals in total. Bridge Collapse

A worker was killed when a bridge under construction collapsed in Rangamati. Another 18 people were injured. The incident took place in Baradom area of the city yesterday morning. The deceased was identified as Rafiqul Islam, 32. His village home is in Sunamganj. The injured are being treated at Rangamati General Hospital. Injured worker Shamim said 30 workers were constructing a bridge in Baradom area of Rangamati-Kaptai road. The bridge collapsed in the middle of the casting.

Dengue

Dengue was decreased in comparison to the previous month. In April, just 3 districts were suffered from dengue. The districts were Dhaka Mahanagar, Sarkhira, Chittagong M.C.H. As usual, Dhaka had the highest number of patients in this month. This table addressed more details.

Fire

According to the [NDRCC](#) report and different dailies, 636 fire incidents took place around the country. Dhaka Division

reported the highest number of fire incidents (196), followed by Chattogram division (116), Rangpur division (53), Rajshahi division (55), Mymensingh division (44), Barishal division (40), Sylhet (43) and Khulna division (89). Among the **636** incidents 119 people died, 12 people were injured, and 118 shops, 4 plastic factories burnt and damaged. The estimated damage was over around 100 crore takas. Flash Flood

Flood was occurred on 4th, 6th, 8th, 17th, 18th and 24th April in Sylhet, Rangpur, Mymensingh. Thousands of acres were submerged. In Mymensingh 20-meter embankment were completely damaged. ([prothomalo.com](#)) In Sylhet, Tahirpur had the most damages. 2000 hectared land of crops were submerged, the water level of Haor was increased and the crops were sunk. [jagonews24.com](#). Lightening

As the month of monsoon started, the lightening incidents was increasing drastically. There were five districts which had the lightening accident and many people lost their lives. The lightening accidents were held in Mymensingh, Sylhet, Chittagong, Dhaka and Rangpur. 27 people were died in these incidents. **More details in annex 5**.

Nor 'wester

In April, Nor 'wester occurred all over the country. People died by a tree falling is the most common scenario in this month. The farmers suffered a lot because their crops were damaged by a northwester. Besides all over the country, Sylhet, Khulna, Chittagong, Dhaka and Rangpur had a visual impact by the northwester. **See annex 6** for more details.

Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion occurred five times in five distinct districts, including Khulna, Mymensingh, Rajshahi, Rangpur, and Dhaka, according to the government. 200 of the embankment in Shatkhira has been washed away into the riverbed. 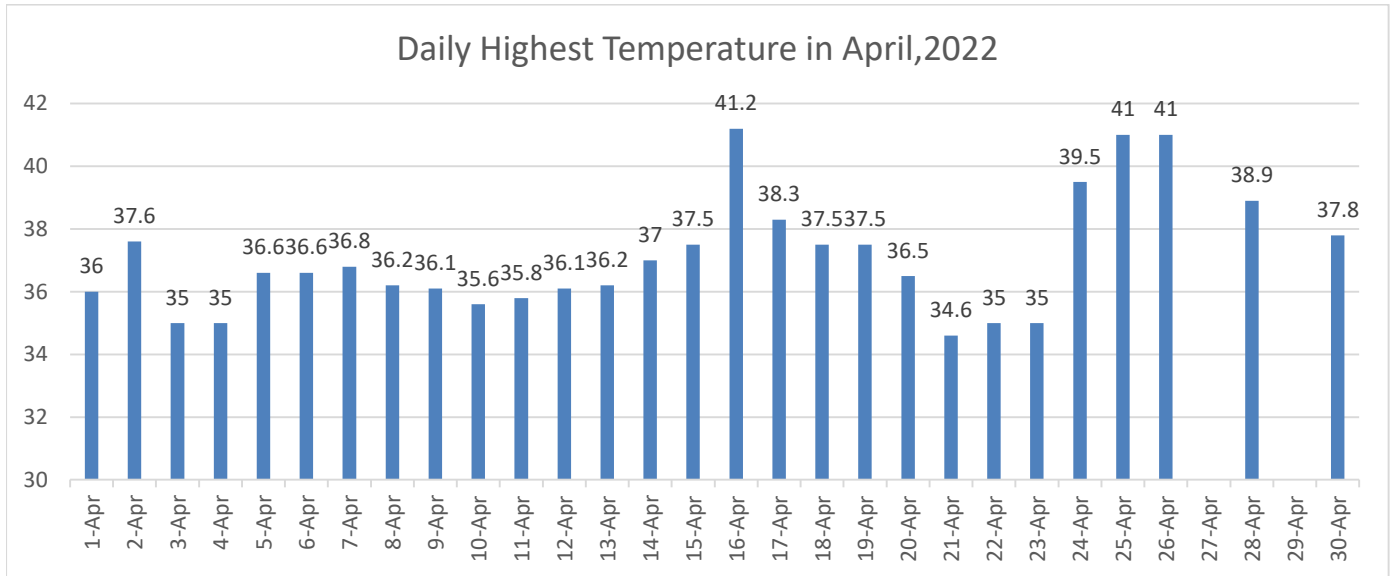

Diarrhoea

Diarrhea had a significant negative impact on our country over the summer months. Dhaka, Bagerhat, Pirojpur, Brahmanbaria, Meherpur, Nilfamari, Brahmanbaria, Barguna, and Rajbari are among the districts that are suffering from severe diarrhea, along with the rest of the country. Many individuals are experiencing diarrhea at this time of year. The number of patients in the hospital is increasing. Rajbari has the greatest number of impacted patients at 110. **More information is included in annex 7.**

Heat Wave

Three heat-waves were flown through 13 districts of the country namely Rangamati, Chandpur, Feni, Sylhet, Dinajpur,



Panchagar, Nilfamari, Patuakhali, Rajshahi, Dhaka, Tangail, Gopalganj, Bogura on 24th to 30th april. In Rajshahi, Pabna, Jessore heatwave were flown on April 20th. ddm.gov.bd The other mild to moderate heat wave was flown through 8 districts such as Pabna, Chuadanga, Dinajpur, Tangail, Faridpur, Khulna, Pabna, Jeshore on April 15th to 19th. ddm.gov.bd No casualties were recorded due to heatwave in April Month. The maximum temperature was recorded 41.2 degree Celsius on 16th April in Rajshahi division and a moderate heatwave was flowing in Dinajpur, Tangail, Faridpur, Khulna and District. ddm.gov.bd

GoB Response in April 2022

Response to Covid-19 up to April 30, 2022

As of 24 April 2022, **12,84,99,399** individuals received their first dose, **11,60,56,535** completed their two-dose schedule and **12,142,706** individuals received the COVID-19 booster dose. The male and female ratio was 49.7% and 50.3% among the people who received the first dose and 49.5% and 50.5% respectively for the second dose. As of 24 April 2022, according to the DGHS Press Release, **1,39,61,944** COVID-19 tests (RT-PCR 89.1%, GeneXpert 0.9%, and Rapid Antigen 10.0%) were conducted in Bangladesh with an overall positivity rate of 13.98% (0.41% in the last 24 hours) by 879 laboratories/test centres. So far, 66.2% of the samples (**92,40,294**) have been tested for COVID-19 in government facilities (RT-PCR 56/160, GeneXpert 54/57, and Rapid Antigen 545/662). During the last week, no test center has been added to the network of COVID-19 testing facilities. who

Government gave 10 lakh taka for Sunamganj ddm.gov.bd.

Conclusion

A total of **12** hazards took place this month of April 2022 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities. The government took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary steps to provide support to the distressed people.
