
















































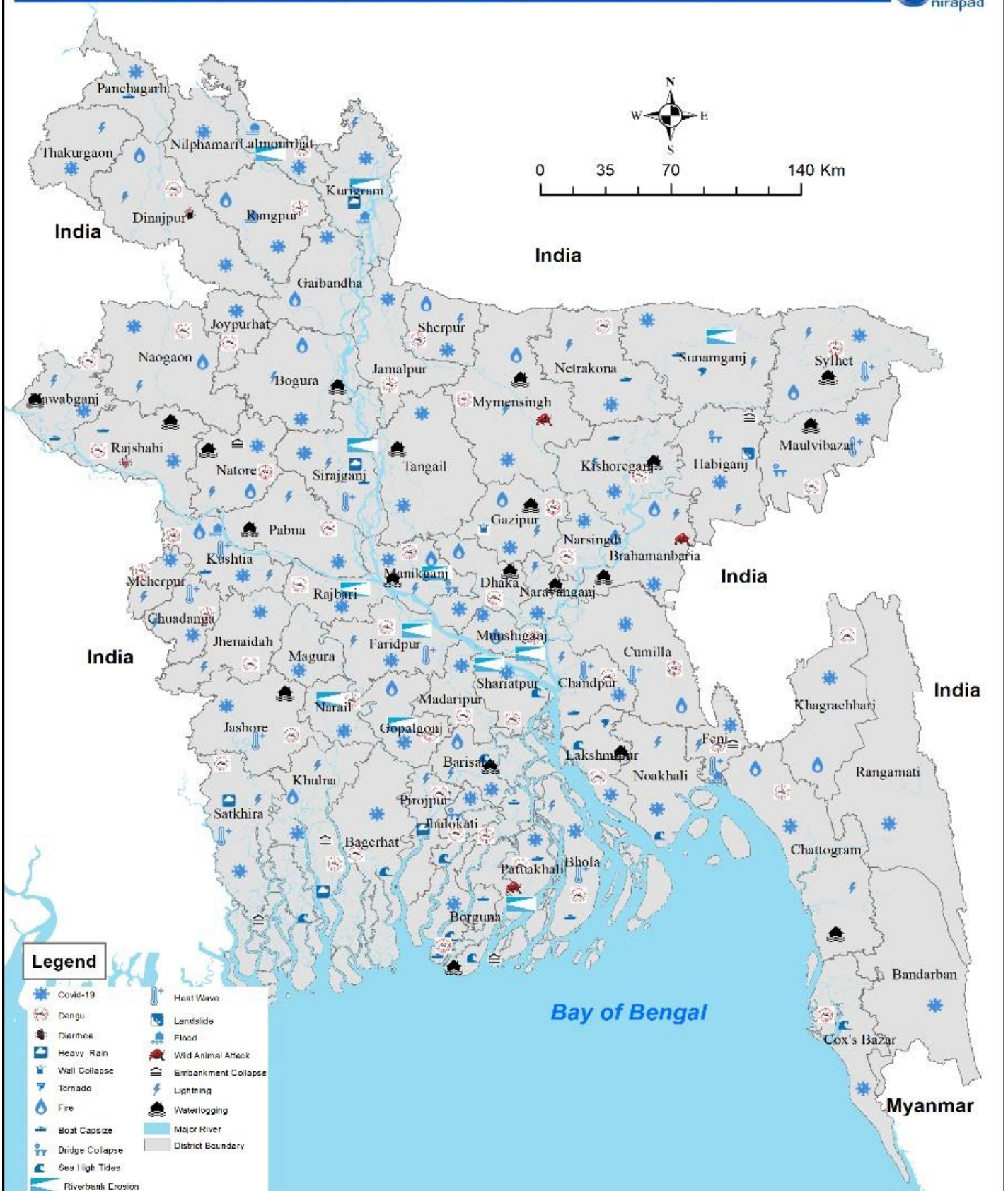


Overview of Hazard Incidences in September 2022

In September 2022, 18 hazards occurred across Bangladesh, including **Boat-Capsize, Bridge Collapse, Dengue, Diarrhea, Covid-19, Embankment Collapse, Fire, Flood, Heavy Rainfall, Heatwave, Lightning, Landslide, Riverbank Erosion, Sea High Tide, Waterlogging, Wall Collapse, Tornado, and Wild Animal Attack**. **Covid 19** affected a total of **13,251** people across the country in a single month. According to the national report published in September 2022, **40** people died and **8705** people were recovered. According to the NDRCC, a total of **443 Fire** incidents occurred throughout the country, resulting in the deaths of 14 people and the injuries of 12 others. **Lightning** had a severe effect in September. 69 people died in 16 different events in 26 districts. **Riverbank erosion** has a big impact in this month. It took place in twelve different districts i.e., Shariatpur, Manikganj, Rajbari, Munsiganj, Kurigram, Sirajganj, Gopalganj, Sunamganj, Faridpur, Lalmonirhat, Rajbari, Patuakhali and Narail. People did not starve to death, but their homestead, cropland, many institutions were destroyed. In September, **Waterlogging** occurred in eight districts and many villages, roads and croplands have been submerged. It was reported that there were two **Heat wave** incidents this month on 2nd and 7th-8th September in 12 districts i.e., Satkhira, Jessore, Faridpur, Sirajganj, Sylhet, Moulvibazar, Chuadanga, Kushtia, Bhola and the highest temperature was recorded at 36.2 degrees Celsius on the 8th of September in Cumilla and Chandpur. **Dengue** fever has a noticeable impact on September as well. In September, 9911 confirmed cases were identified. The most devastating of which was **14 Boat Capsized** occurred in 13 different districts, which caused died of 74 people, 11 were missing. Eight **Embankment Collapse** occurred in Habiganj, Natore, Satkhira, Patuakhali, Feni and Khulna districts. It causes flood, submerged many of fish enclosures. 35 villages, lowlands and croplands have been submerged due to **Heavy Rainfall**. Four **Bridge Collapse** took place in Moulavibzar, Jhalokathi, Habiganj and Manikganj districts. **Sea High Tides** affected 10 districts and people were suffering due to inundating areas. There were three incidents of **Wild Animal Attack** in three different districts Pauakhali, Brahmanbaria and Mymensingh, which caused 32 people injured and two farmers died. One **Wall Collapse** took place in Gazipur on 17th September. The number of **Diarrhea** patients were increased in Rajshahi and Rangpur divisions in the first week of this month. A landslide occurred on 5th September in Habiganj district. Two **Tornado** occurred in Lauxmipur and Sunamganj districts on 9th and 24th September. About 28,000 people have been suffering due to **Monsoon Flood** in Lalmonirhat, Rangpur, Kurigram and Kushtia districts. One **Landslide** occurred in Habiganj on 5th September 22, Where Vehicle communication was disrupted.

Description of Hazard Incidents in September 2022

Boat Capsize

14 Boat Capsized occurred in 13 different districts, which caused died of 74 people, 11 were missing. 69 people were died in Panchagarh districts, which was terrible incident in this month. 11 people were missing also in Kushtia, Nawabganj, Sirajganj, Barguna, Chandpur and Sunamganj districts. 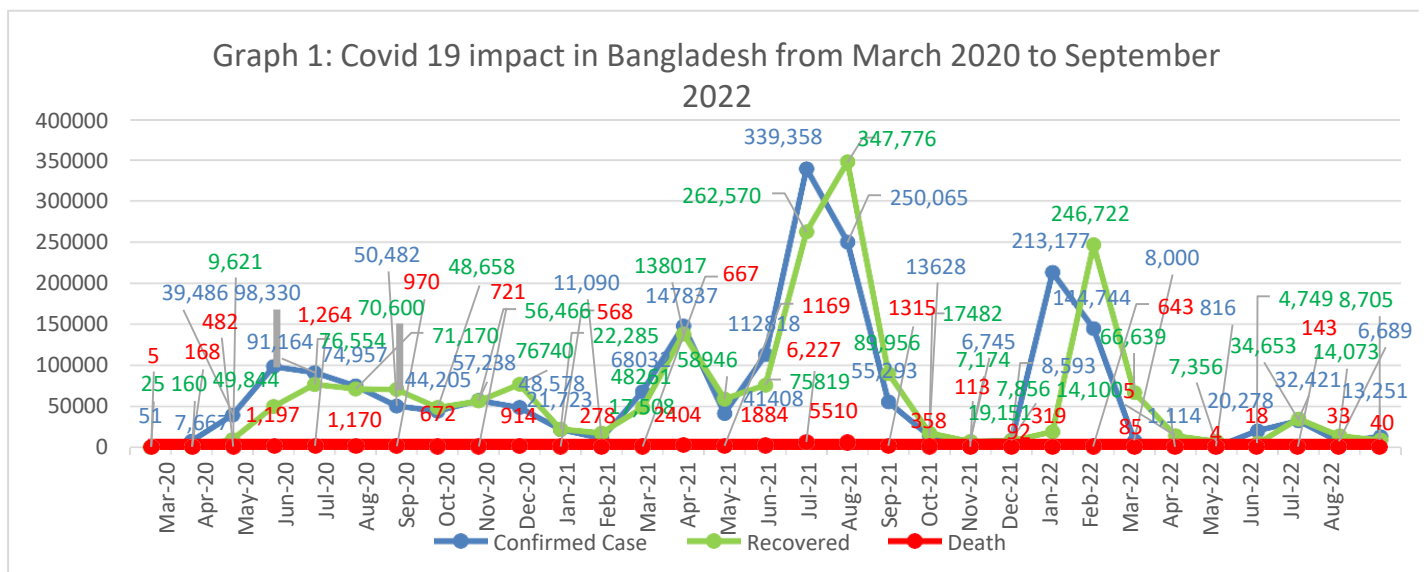
Bridge Collapse

Four bridge collapse happened in 3 different districts which cause many problems like traffic being stopped for two days, Road separated from the city, and Local people suffering.

Covid-19

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 was **13,251** from 1st September to 30th September 2022. In this month **8,705** persons recovered, and the total death was **40** which indicates both the number of deaths, and the confirmed cases are increasing compared to the previous month. From the very first case identified on March 8, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patients is **2,008,870** among which **29,313** persons died and **19,51,322** persons recovered from **14,677,240** tested samples in total up to August 15th, 2022, according to who See **Annex 1** and **Annex 2** for more details on the month of September.



Dengue

Dengue increased in comparison to the previous month. In September, just **51** districts suffered from dengue, and as usual, Dhaka has the highest cases and deaths also. In September **9911** confirmed cases were identified and 34 people died. **See the details in annex 6.**

Diarrhea

The number of diarrhea patients has increased in Rajshahi due to heat. (Source: bd-pratidin.com 3 September 22). On 2 September 22, Diarrhea patients increased in Hili (Dinajpur) (Source: bd-pratidin.com).

Embankment Collapse

Eight Embankment Collapse occurred in six districts. It causes flood and submerges many of fish enclosures. Three embankment collapse was occurred on 12th, 15th, 16th September in Satkhira districts. Others incident occurred in Habiganj, Natore, Patuakhali, Feni and Khulna where villages were at risk.

According to the [NDRCC](#) report and different dailies, 636 fire incidents took place around the country. Dhaka Division

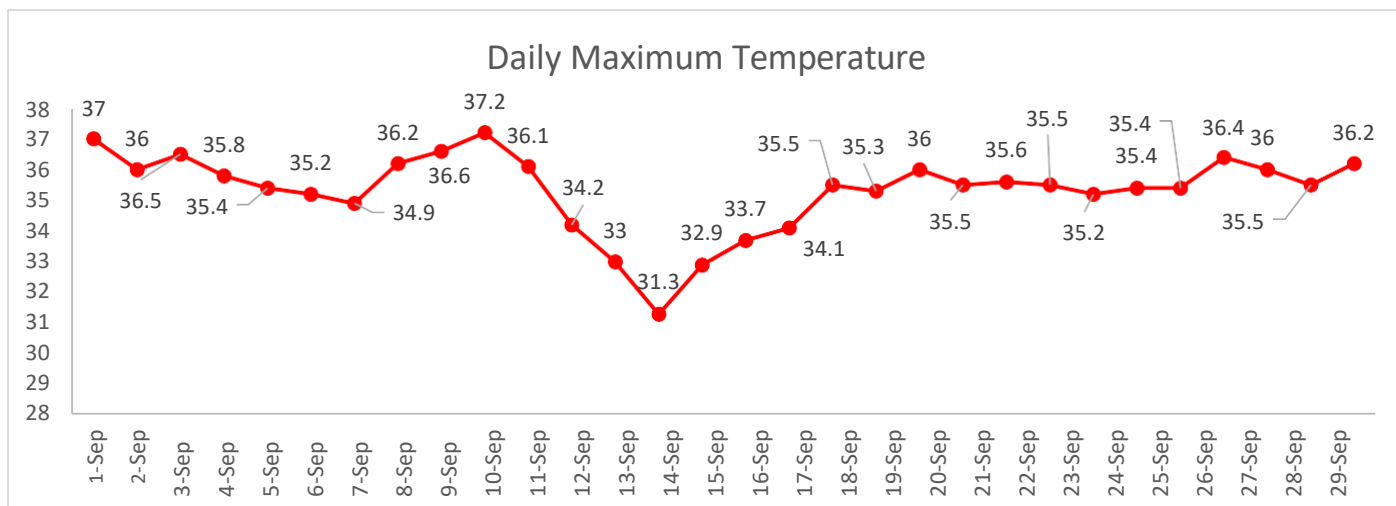

reported the highest number of fire incidents (154), followed by Chattogram division (70), Rangpur division (27), Rajshahi division (52), Mymensingh division (28), Barishal division (19), Sylhet (26) and Khulna division (67). Among the **443** incidents 14 people died, 12 people were injured, 200 birds died and 55 houses, 32 shops, three jute factories burnt and damaged. The estimated damage was over around 40 lakh takas. See more details in **Annex 3**.

Heat Wave

It was reported that there were two Heat wave incidents this month on 2nd and 7th-8th September in 12 districts i.e., Satkhira, Jessore, Faridpur, Sirajganj, Sylhet, Moulvibazar, Chuadanga, Kushtia, Bhola and the highest temperature was recorded at 36.2 degrees Celsius on the 8th of September in Cumilla and Chandpur. On 2 September 2022, a mild heatwave is sweeping over Jessore and Kushtia district. On this day, the highest temperature in the country was recorded in Satkhira and Jessore. The temperature in both districts was 36 degrees Celsius. On this day, the maximum temperature recorded in Dhaka was 35.1 degrees Celsius. (Source: jagonews24.com)

On 7 September 2022, a mild heat wave was moving over Cumilla, Chandpur, Jessore and Satkhira district. On Wednesday, the highest temperature in the country was 36.2 degrees Celsius in Cumilla and Chandpur. And the maximum temperature in Dhaka was 35 degrees Celsius. (Source: jagonews24.com).

Heavy Rainfall

35 villages, lowlands and croplands have been submerged due to Heavy Rainfall in September 22. Kurigram, Pirojpur, Satkhira, Sirajganj, Khulna districts were affected, and people were suffering. See details:

Landslide

One Landslide occurred in Habiganj on 5th September 22, Where Vehicle communication was disrupted. (jugantor.com 5- September 22).

Lightning

The lightening incidents was increasing drastically. In September Lightening had a severe effect. 69 people died in 16 different events in 26 districts and 34 people were injured. **More details in annex 4.**

Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion has a big impact in this month. It took place in twelve different districts i.e., Shariatpur, Manikganj, Rajbari, Munsiganj, Kurigram, Sirajganj, Gopalganj, Sunamganj, Faridpur, Lalmonirhat, Rajbari, Patuakhali and Narail. People did not starve to death, but their homestead, cropland, many institutions were destroyed. 58 families of the same village have become homeless in the Lohagora Upazila of Narial districts. **See details in annex 8**

Sea High Tides

Sea High Tides affected 10 districts and people were suffering due to inundating areas. In this month, sea high tides have made a big negative impact on Bagerhat, Barguna, Barishal, Patuakhali, Jhalokathi, Pirojpur, Noakhali and Shariatpur. More than 160 villages were waterlogged and the low-lying areas of all the districts of Barisal division were flooded. **More details in annex 9.**

Tornado

In September two tornado took place in Bangladesh. First one occurred in Meghna River at Laxmipur district on 9-September-2022 (Source: jagonews24.com) and another one occurred at a Haor in Sunamganj district on 24-September-2022. (source: jamuna.tv.news)

Wall Collapse

One Wall Collapse took place in Gazipur on 17th September 22. It caused one death and one injured. Source: bd-pratidin.com 17-September 22

Waterlogging

In September, Waterlogging occurred in 22 districts and many villages, homesteads, roads and croplands have been submerged. Three incidents were occurred in Dhaka and created severe traffic jams. **See details in annex 10.**

Wild Animal Attack

There were three incidents of **Wild Animal Attack** in three different districts Pauakhali, Brahmanbaria and Mymensingh, which caused 32 people injured and two farmers died. See details
