















































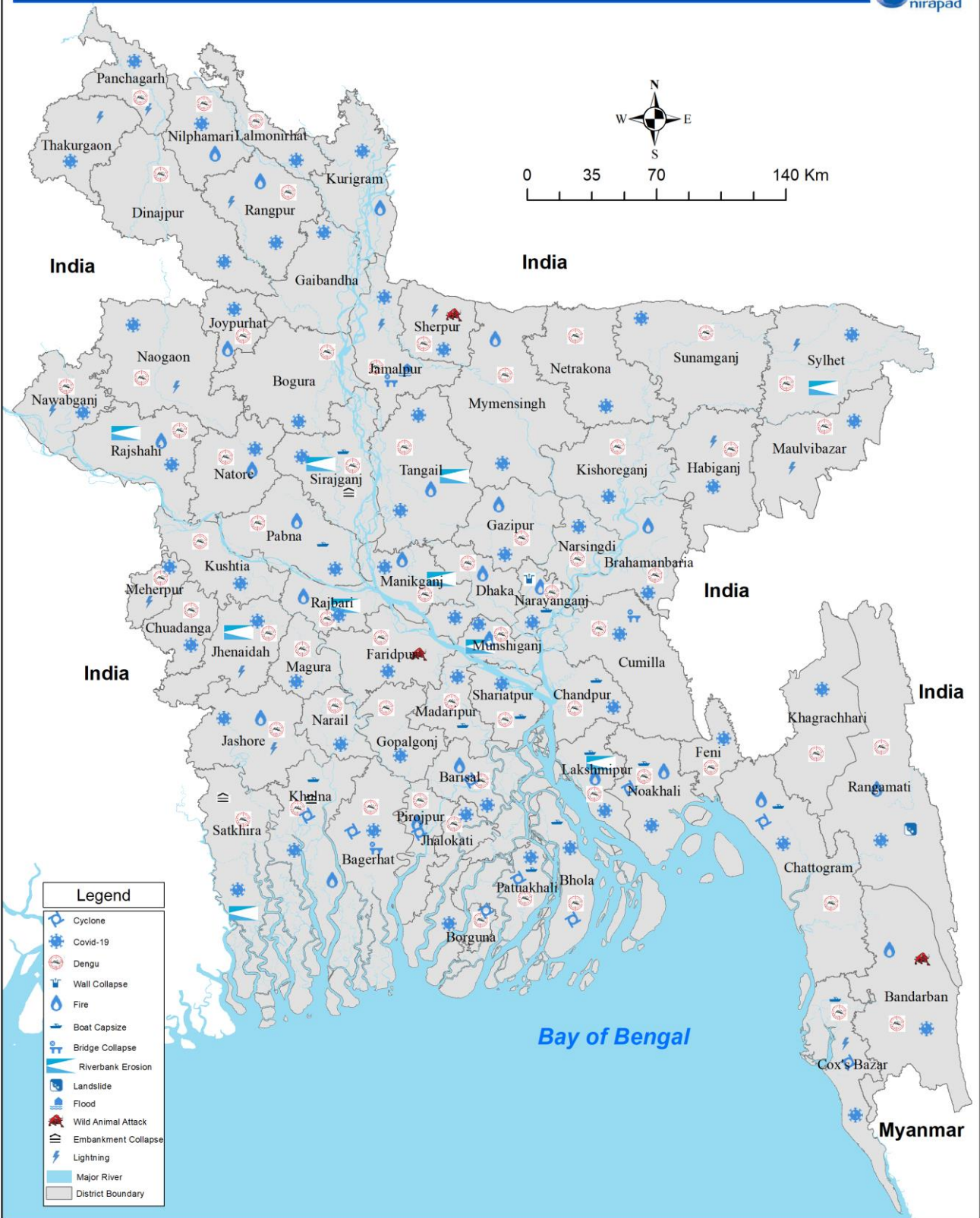
Overview of Hazard Incidences in October 2022

In October 2022, 13 types of hazard incidents occurred across Bangladesh, including **Boat Capsize, Covid-19, Cyclone, Dengue, Fire, Monsoon Flood, Riverbank Erosion, Landslide, Bridge Collapse, Wild Animal Attack, Lightning, Wall Collapse, and Embankment Collapse**. Covid-19 affected a total number of **10,043** people across the country in October 2022. According to the national report published in October 2022, due to Covid-19, **60** people died and **15,636** people recovered. On the basis of the [DGHS](#) daily situation report, dengue was more rigorous in October compared to September month 2022. It caused of death **86** people and **21,934** confirmed cases were identified in October month in **61** districts. On 24 October **Cyclone Sitrang** hit 10 coastal districts namely Khulna, Bagerhat, Barguna, Patuakhali, Bhola, Noakhali, Cox's Bazar, Chattogram, Pirojpur and Barishal districts in Bangladesh. The monetary value of the lost crop was approximately 1.02 million US dollars. Total affected people by cyclone Sitrang were **9,68,793** and **15** people died. With reference to the daily hazard situation report of [MoDMR](#) and [DDM](#), a total of **467** Fire incidents occurred in 24 districts, resulting in the deaths of 10 people and the injuries of **25** others. **Lightning** had a severe effect on October 2022. **24** people died and 3 were injured due to 17 different lightning events in 16 districts. **Riverbank Erosion** has had a big impact this month. It took place in nine different districts i.e., Manikganj, Rajbari, Munsiganj, Sirajganj, Sylhet, Rajshashi, Jhenaidah, Tangail, and Satkhira. People did not starve to death, but their homestead, cropland, and many institutions were destroyed.

15 instances of Boat Capsized occurred in 13 different districts, which caused death of **25** people and **8** people went missing in October 2022. **3 Embankment Collapse** occurred in Satkhira, Sirajganj, and Khulna districts. Approximately 222-meter embankment was washed away into rivers. Three **Bridge Collapse** took place in Cumilla Jamalpur, Bagerhat districts where one person was injured. There were three incidents of **Wild Animal Attack** in three different districts namely Sherpur, Bandarban and Faridpur, which caused the death of 10-15 goats and 1 farmer, also 2 people were injured. One **Wall Collapsed** at Narayanganj causing the death of one person on 21 October 2022. A **Monsoon Flood** has been occurred Sadar Upazilla in Jamalpur District. Amon, Ropa and vegetable fields were inundated. One **Landslide** took place in Chattogram on 5th October 2022, due to which vehicle communication was disrupted.

Description of Hazard Incidents in October 2022

Boat Capsize

15 Boat Capsized occurred in 13 different districts, which caused 25 deaths, and 8 people were missing. 6 people have died in Chattogram district, which was a terrible incident this month. Also 31 Rohingya people were rescued in Cox's Bazar district. 6 people were missing Khulna, Chattogram, Pabna districts. For more details, see **annex: 4**

Bridge Collapse

Three bridge collapse happened in 3 different districts in October 2022, which caused 1 injured and many problems like Several educational institutions and vast crop lands are under threat.

Cyclone Sitrang

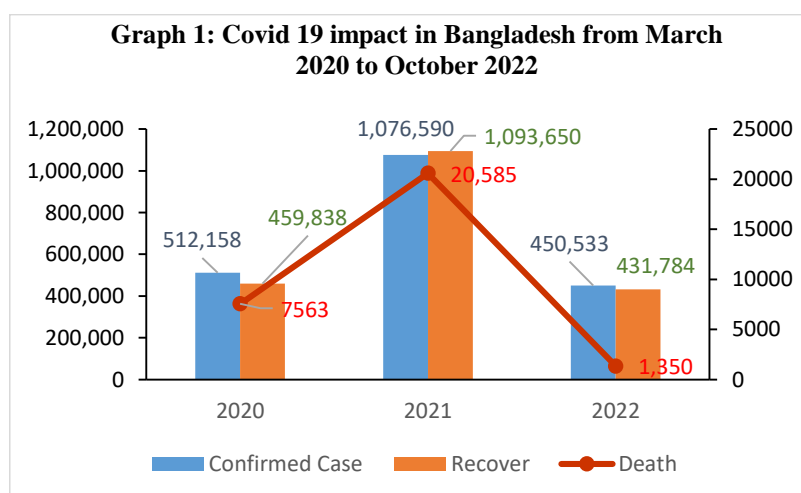
Bangladesh is a delta nation of more than 160 million people and is prone to natural disasters such as floods and cyclones. Cyclone Sitrang was a tropical cyclone that affected India and Bangladesh on 24 October 2022. Formed on 22 October offshore Andaman and Nicobar Islands, it gradually intensified and peaked as a high-end cyclonic storm before making landfall over Bangladesh close to Barisal by the early hours of 24 October. According to [NAWG](#) Cyclone Sitrang hit seven districts in Bangladesh. Total affected people were 968,793 and died 15 people. Source:[NAWG](#).

Covid-19

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 was **10,043** from 1st October to 31 October 2022. In this month **15,636** people recovered, and the total death was **60** which indicates both the number of deaths, and the confirmed cases are increasing compared to the previous month. From the very first case identified on March 8, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patients is **2,035,240** among which **29,423** persons died and **1,980,828** persons recovered from **15,004,009** tested samples in total up to 17 October-2022, according to [who](#) See **Annex 1** for more details on the month of October.



Dengue

Dengue increased in comparison to the previous month. In October, just **61** districts suffered from dengue, and as usual, Dhaka has the highest confirmed cases and deaths. In September where the number of confirmed cases was **9,911** while in October it reached **21,932** confirmed cases and the death toll increased from **34** to **86** people. **See the details in annex 5.**

Embankment Collapse

Three Embankment Collapse occurred in 3 districts in entire October. Three embankment collapse occurred on 21st, 23rd, 27 October in Satkhira, Sirajganj, and Khulna respectively where villages were at risk. Approximately 222-meters embankment was washed away into rivers. See below table for more details.

Fire

According to the [NDRCC](http://ndrcc.gov.bd) report and different dailies, 467 fire incidents took place across the country. Dhaka Division reported the highest number of fire incidents (143), followed by Chattogram division (81), Khulna division (71), Rajshahi division (56), Mymensingh division (36), Sylhet division (32), Rangpur division (28) and Barishal division (20). Among the 467 incidents, 10 people died and 25 people were injured. The estimated damage was over around 7 crore and 65 lakh takas. See more details in **Annex 2**.

Lightning

The lightening incidents increased drastically in this month. In October Lightening had a severe effect. 24 people died and 3 people were injured in 17 different lightning events in 14 districts. More details in **annex 3**.

Landslide

One Landslide occurred in Chattogram on 5th October 2022, due to which vehicle communication was disrupted. (prothomalo.com 5- October 22).

Monsoon Flood

There was one monsoon flood have been occurred Sadar Upazilla in Jamalpur District. Amon, Ropa and vegetable fields were inundated. (Source: samakal.com 19 october-2022).

Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion has a big impact in this month. It took place in nine different districts i.e., Manikganj, Rajbari, Munsiganj, Sirajganj, Sylhet, Rajshahi, Jhenaidah, Tangail, Satkhira in several days. People did not starve to death, but their homestead, cropland, many institutions were destroyed. 15 residential houses were damaged by the riverbank erosion in Ghior Upazila in Manikganj district. **See details in annex 6**

Wall Collapse

One Wall Collapse took place in Narayanganj on 21st October 22. It caused one death. Source: jugantor.com 21-October 22

Wild Animal Attack

There were three incidents of **Wild Animal Attack** in three different districts llike Sherpur, Bandarban and Faridpur, which caused 10-15 goats died and one farmer died and two were injured.

As of 16 October 2022, **135,195,632** individuals received their first dose, **123,917,458** completed their two-dose schedule, and **57 294,620** received the COVID-19 booster dose. More than **79.4%** of the total population received the first dose, and **72.8%** completed the two doses schedule (as per the estimated population of 170 317 077, by Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics, 1 July 2021). The male and female ratio was 49.9% and **50.1%** among the people who received the first dose and 49.7% and **50.3%**, respectively, for the second dose. For details-WHO
