













































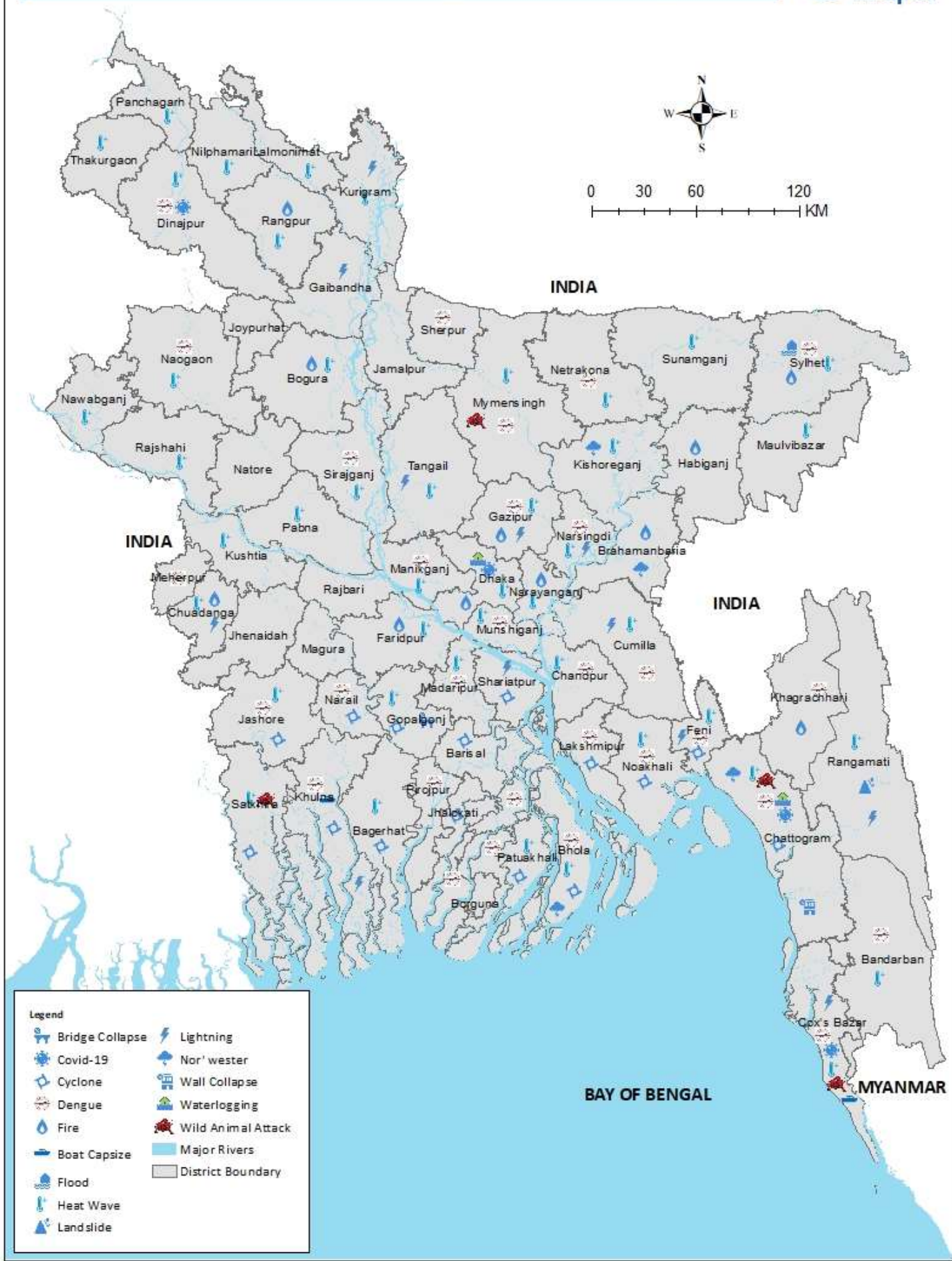


Overview of Hazard Incidences in May 2024

In May 2024, **fourteen** types of hazard incidents occurred across Bangladesh, including, **Cyclone, Boat Capsize, Covid-19, Dengue, Fire, Heat Wave, Land Slide, Flood, Waterlogging, Lightening, Nor'wester, Bridge collapse, Wall Collapse, and Wild Animal Attacks**. Based on the [DGHS](#) daily situation report, the confirmed cases and deaths of **Dengue** stayed stable in May compared with April month and it is increasing slightly. In this month it spread about **31** Districts of Bangladesh and total confirmed cases were **2853** identified and **2,707** were recovered where the total death was **36**. According to the daily newspaper, **20** **Lightning** incidents were recorded which resulted in the cause of death toll of **25** people, and **14** people got injured in different districts. **One** event of cyclone has occurred in Bangladesh in May. According to situational reports and daily newspapers, **19** districts were impacted by the cyclone named **Cyclone Remal**. A total **16** people killed and **22** people missing or injured. Concerning the daily hazard situation report of [MoDMR](#) and [DDM](#), **568** fire incidents have occurred where **six** people killed, **three** people were injured, and according to the daily newspapers **14** fire accidents have occurred in May where **two** people killed and several got injured, at least **40 lakh** worth property damaged along with many houses and business places. The number of newly identified patients with COVID-19 was **480** in May 2024. In this month **453** people have **recovered**, and **1** death which indicates both the number of deaths and the confirmed cases are very same compared to April. **One** incident of **Boat Capsize** happened in Cox Bazar which caused total twelve boats to capsizes near Moheshkhali. **Three** **Wild Animal Attack** events took place on several dates in May which resulted in **two** deaths and one injured and different resources damaged in different districts. On the other hand, one incident of **Land Slide** occurred at Baghaichori upazila in Rangamati. Based on different national dailies. **Waterlogging** occurred in several districts of Bangladesh. **Four** incidents of **nor 'wester** took place in different districts where two people killed. Besides, the country has experienced a total of **3** different levels of **heat waves** throughout the country where **mild to moderate, and extreme to very extreme** heat waves. The maximum temperature was recorded at **43.8** degrees Celsius at **Jessore**. **One** incident of **Bridge Collapse** occurred in Gopalganj. A sudden **flash flood** occurred in four upazilas of Sylhet leaving **three** lakh people stranded. One incident of wall collapse has occurred in Chattogram district where a youth have killed.

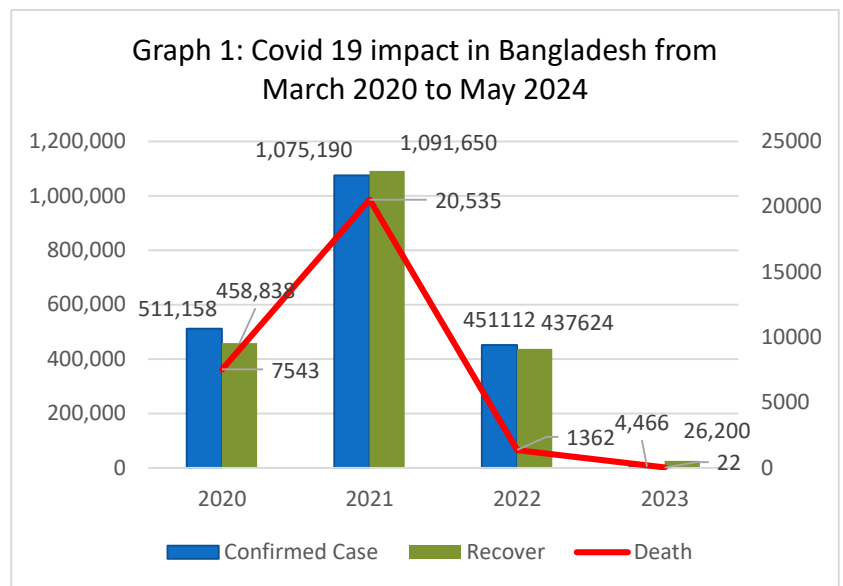
Hazard Incidence in Bangladesh, May 2024



Description of Hazard Incidences in May 2024

Covid-19

The number of newly identified patients with **Covid-19** is **480** from **1st** May to **31st** May 2024. In this month **453** people have **recovered**, and **one** death which indicates both the number of death and the confirmed cases are very same compared to April. The total number of confirmed cases is **2050577** from the first identification of COVID-19 in Bangladesh in March 2020. The total death and recovered to the end of May was **29495** and **2017880** respectively [DGHS](#). See the details in [Annex 1](#) for more detail information.



Dengue

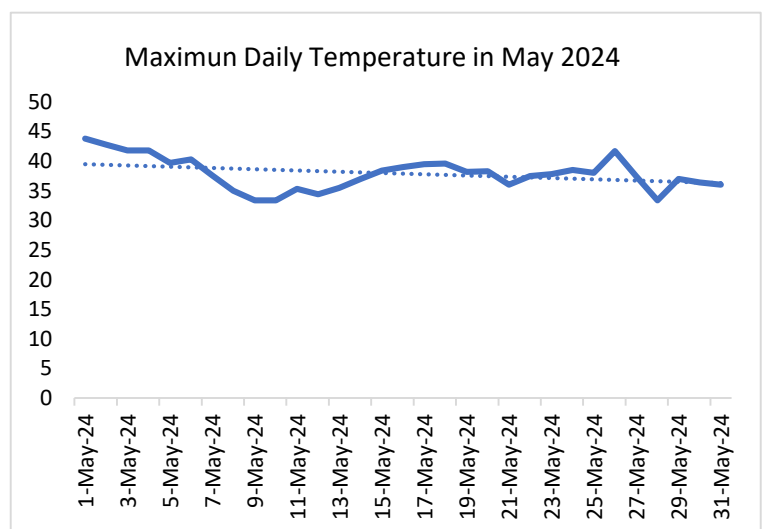
Based on [DGHS](#) daily situation report, the confirmed cases and deaths of **Dengue** increased in May compared with April month. In May, half of the districts suffered from dengue, and as usual, **Dhaka** has the highest number of confirmed cases (**225**) and deaths (**11**). Secondly, the Narshingdi district confirms cases (**56**) and deaths (**0**). In May the total number of confirmed cases are **644** and a total of **12** people killed whereas in April it was lower compared to May. In this month it spread about 31 Districts of Bangladesh. See the details in [Annex 2](#).

Fire

According to the NDRCC report total of 568 fire incidents took place across the country in May 2024. Dhaka division reported the highest number of fire incidents (**211**), followed by Khulna division (**108**) Rajshahi division (51), Rangpur division (**51**), Chattogram division (**49**), Mymensingh division, (**48**), Sylhet division (**31**), Barishal Division (**19**). Among the **568** incidents, six people killed, three people got injured and several damages to property have occurred. In May, a total of 14 fire incidents were reported in daily newspapers in different districts of Bangladesh. Two people were dead and seven people got injured. A total of 40 shops and business places and 108 houses were brought down along with 65 bighas of crops were destroyed by fire. For more details, see [Annex 3](#) and the below table.

Heatwave

According to NDRCC in this month, there were **2 Heat Wave** events, **one** is **mild to moderate** and **very extreme** occurred between **1 to 7 May**, **one mild to moderate** heat wave event from 15-17 May. Three mild heatwave events occurred in 12-14, 20-24 and 26 May. The maximum temperature was recorded at **43.8** degrees Celsius at **Jessore** during heat wave situations, on **1st May 2024**. The daily maximum temperature showed a positive trend in May compared to April 2024. More details in [Annex 4](#).



Land Slide

One incident of **Land Slide** occurred on **3rd May** 2024 at Baghaichori upazila in Rangamati ([thedailystar](#)).

Lightning

This month, **20 Lightning** incidents are recorded which resulted in the cause of death toll of **25** people and 14 people get injured different districts. There were **12** districts namely Rangamati, Cox Bazar, Shariatpur, Chuadanga, Bagerhat, Comilla, Gaibandha, Narshingdi, Tangail, Gazipur, Feni and Kurigram where lightning event recorded. Nor'wester

Four incidents of **nor 'wester** took place on different dates in different places in Bangladesh in May. 2 events occurred in 5th May in Chattogram ([prothomalo](#)) and Kishorganj. 1 pregnant woman and her 5 years old son killed in Kishorganj ([prothomalo](#)). 2 events occurred in 6th May in B.Baria and Chattogram district. ([prothomalo](#) [prothomalo](#)) More details in [Annex 6](#).

Waterlogging

Based on different national dailies, waterlogging occurred in Chattogram and Dhaka at different upazila. In Dhaka, 87 mm of rainfall caused waterlogging in different areas including Kawranbazar. In Chattogram, 97.7 mm rainfall caused waterlogging. 143 mm rainfall caused heavy waterlogging in Dhaka on 27th May resulting endless suffering to the people ([prothomalo](#)) ([bdpratidin](#)) ([samakal](#)). Flood

One flash flood occurred in Sylhet on 30th May due to heavy rainfall. Around 3 lakh people stranded due to the flood ([thedailystar](#)).

Wild Animal Attack

Three wild animal attack events took place on several dates in May which resulted in **two** deaths and one injured. On 12th May 2024 a wild elephant attacked in Mymensingh district Haluaghat upazila which death of a farmer ([prothomalo](#)). On 19th May 2024, a elephants attacked at Lohagara Upazila in Chattogram where **one** woman killed ([thebusinessstandard](#)). On the other hand, in Satkhira at Sundarban Upazila a forester gets injured by a crocodile ([prothomalo](#)). More details in [Annex 8](#).

Boat Capsize

One incident of boat capsized happened in Cox Bazar which caused a total **12** boats capsized on 8 May 2024. No missing or casualties were recorded ([thedailystar](#)).

Bridge Collapse

One incident of bridge collapse happened on 27th May in Gopalganj. The bridge over 'Shir Khal' near Silna Bazar on Bedgram-Silna Road in Sadar Upazila caved in on Monday when a nearby tree, uprooted by the cyclone's fierce winds and the strong canal currents, fell onto it ([bdnews24](#)).

Wall Collapse

One wall collapse incident took place in Chattogram district. One young man aged 26 killed due to the wall collapse ([bangladeshpost](#)).

Cyclone

Cyclone Remal slammed into Bangladesh coast on 26th May. It has impacted 19 districts of Bangladesh. 4.6 million people were affected where 2.3 M were female, 1.79 M were children, and huge number of elderly, pregnant and people with disability got affected. 16 people were killed in this cyclone and 22 people got injured or missing. 80,591 Hectare (Ha) of cultivable land inundated, 20260 tubewells and 134,269 latrines get damaged. Social, Economic, Educational functions disrupted due to this devastating cyclone event ([NAWG](#)).

GoB Response in May 2024

Response to Waterlogging

In Dhaka district during a waterlogging incident on 28 May 2024, Dhaka City Corporation Quick Response team cleared all the uprooted trees from the roads. DNCC allocated 5300 workers to clean the water passing ways in Dhaka North. DSCC's 91 teams were working in Dhaka South.

Response to Cyclone

In response to Cyclone Remal government took the initiative for early warning and emergency evacuation. In response, [MoDMR](#) allocated 106,500,000 taka cash for affected people in 19 districts of the country.

Conclusion

A total of **Fourteen types of** hazards took place in May 2024 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities.
